

## North Union United - COVID19 GUIDELINES

These have been developed for NUU based on the recommendations of our Leagues (NCP, CPYSL, EDP).

### PARENTS

- Sit on the same side as the team, family units socially distant from each other, masks should be worn when social distancing is not possible between family units
- Sit 10 feet + behind sideline to give AR appropriate distance.
- Should not handle balls except with feet and unless to protect themselves
- Should review any symptoms with their child and take their temperature prior to leaving home for the game. If unwell call the coach and stay home.
- All parents and family members MUST wear masks at all times.

### TEAMS

- Players and coaches wear masks upon arriving to the field until leaving the field.
- Players MUST wear masks at all times, including pre-game warm up; except when subbing and actively playing in the game.
- Players must bring their own clearly identifiable water bottles
- Coaches MUST wear masks at all times.
- No team benches - players may bring their own chairs and should be separated 6 feet apart. Parents should be at least 10 feet away from the team area and should not interact with the team at the bench area.
- No team Water coolers / bottles or shared items other than soccer balls
- Only coaches will handle equipment.
- Home team will supply game balls and pre-disinfect them before the game
- No pre or post game team huddles.
- Maintain distance during half time.
- After the game no handshaking or fist bumping - teams should line up at their team area and wave and offer good sportsmanship to the other team.
- Team should clear the field area immediately following the game.
- Teams/referees should keep their copy of the days' rosters for contact tracing if needed.
- If a team cannot play due to COVID issues notify the league ASAP. No one should participate if they are feeling unwell or are at high risk.
- Standings are NOT important this season – this is strictly about providing the kids an opportunity to play as safely as possible.

### REPORTING
