- Presented May minutes, which were sent in advance through USAW Membership website to review and provide updates
- Motion to accept minutes presented by Ben Nicely.
- Roby Webster seconded the motion.
- Motion passed unanimously

Treasurer: Jeff Strueder

- We are cash heavy but going into biggest expense time of the year.
- Transferred to money to the account that is tied to Lou Silverman's debit card for trip next week.
- Have had issues with cards being declined recently. Chase has changed their policy. We get a text/email to approve.
- Presenting updated financials as the report is from a week ago.
- Equipment sale higher due to garage sale. Site search \$175 this week.
- Strong year for freestyle state.
- 14U duals income took in \$15,000 91% of budget (5% goes to credit card fees).
- Cadet duals income took in less than anticipated. Next year suggesting we budget for 1 team
- Went through the financials that are on the website (USA Membership)
- Cultural Exchange within range of budget.
- Junior Duals income slightly down, but within range.
- Junior Duals women, close to budget.
- Kid's national trip income is down due to change in location and change in form of the trip. Expenses will be more than anticipated.
- Women's Fargo lower than budgeted, but we budgeted aggressively
- 14U we were close
- Central Regionals double the budget
- Central Regionals expenses, quite a bit off due to not in a high school.
- State Summit started getting expenses in.

- Had some additional expenses coming in for camps.
- 16U camp was a little more than in the past.
- Went through travel expenses.
- Junior Duals are starting to come in. We budget on a per person basis and take the total and split between Juniors and Cadets.
- Fargo is combined on expenses.
- Pat Culp discussed that Central Regionals has gone up to 3-year contract so we won't be hosting for a while (after this year) due to the other 4 states in our region having the opportunity to host. Also, that we did better financially due to increase in entry fees. She has reached out to the coliseum due to hospitality costs.
- She explained that USA Wrestling wants to have their tournaments out of schools and in some type of professional venue.
- Discussed potential sites if we continue to host USA tournaments. Discussed looking for grants to assist.
- Discussion of USA Wrestling bidding process and the advantages of 2-year notice of location, making budgeting easier. Not doing that at this time.
- We are in a much better shape that we had budgeted for.
- As we move to the budget meeting will get information to team leaders (data)
- Jason Miller made a motion to accept the treasurer's report
- Roby Webster seconded the report
- Motion passed unanimously.

• Law & Legislation – Steve Pugliese

- Not present. No report
- o Pat Culp talked to him in the last week or so regarding a situation.
- We have 4 sets of parents for the women that were asking a lot of questions about Fargo. She met with them on zoom and talked with the Executive Board, USA Wrestling and Steve Pugliese. They were concerned about the Fargo camp was mandatory.
- Talked to Thomas Pompei concern of the food and Thomas confirmed they will make meals that are high quality foods.
- Wanted to make sure the girls are on separate floors, separate dorms, or even in hotels.
 Thomas Pompei confirmed he has requested 2 separate floors for the dorm.
- o Pat Culp is going to hold a meeting for all coaches going to Fargo.
- Several people are saying they want to drive their kids out and stay with them. Pat said Colorado, Texas and Utah handle things differently. She called their state chairs and also Wisconsin. Some have ala carte – adjustments for already have gear, travel etc. Camps are mandatory.
- o Steve Pugliese said after SafeSport came out, we can no longer require them to travel and stay with the team.
- O Jason DeLois said there will be 4 females as coach/chaperones. He said we can add another female coach if needed, from Indiana Tech wrestlers.

- o JD Minch said USA Wrestling does not allow wrestlers to wrestle unattached.
- o Discussed ISWA cost and we are paying anything over and above the \$1,200 (cost of the trip for the athletes).
- o Working with Steve Pugliese to get the waiver and code of conduct forms.

Women's Director – Jason DeLois

 - 2. Weights would like for them to be able to select their own weights.

- Needs link for Junior Girls for registration. 29 girls registered
- Women's Junior Duals 30 teams competed we placed 8th in the country.
- Would like us to consider donating \$500 to a program being used to grow women's wrestling at USAW level. Will send information to Pat Culp to review.
- Discussed the participation of Indiana Tech wrestling and all they did to help.

Cultural Exchange Director – Lou Silverman

- Leaving on Tuesday morning for their trip. There are 11 wrestlers going. They are all set
- Had a practice at Carmel HS on 6/11. All but 1 was there.
- Danny Struck and Lou Silverman led the practice.

■ Folkstyle Developmental Director – Ryan Parrish

- Committee met and changed awards up a little bit due to them being the same for a long period of time.
- Would also like to change and have a banquet outside of the annual meeting.
- Would like to have the brunch for awards on Sunday after the budget meeting. There are 55 winners
- Having a hard time locating a venue that can host.
- Looking at wrestler and 2 guests for free.
- We are looking at approximately \$3000.
- Jeff Strueder made a motion allocate up to \$3000 for this awards banquet.
- Linda Robison seconded the motion.
- Motion passed unanimously.
- Ryan asked for anyone knowing a school that can host let him know. Will be held on Sunday morning after the budget meeting.

Additional items:

Bidding local tournaments – Ben Nicely:

- Now set up and open for bidding.
- Google docs form set up
- Will close a couple of days before the annual meeting
- As we get closer will update more frequently
- Late submissions will go before the tournament change sub-committee
- Intent to bid must be noted prior to the end of the annual meeting.
- Have to bid using our established process.
- Must submit the form and must have a secondary date.
- If they don't follow the procedure, they will receive a disciplinary letter.
- There are possibilities of hardship, but must be proven.
- If they wish to change the date, they must submit a form requesting the change. If the new date conflicts with another club, then they will not be approved.
- Will have section directors send an email letting them know the process is open.
- Has talked to coaches' who will be receiving disciplinary letters
- Pat Culp also stated we need to get notifications out for clubs wanting to bid for state and USA tournaments for 2 years and provide deadline. One date for everything. Ben will draw something up and get that information out.
