Sundance, Brighton and Solitude Resorts

A deluxe motor coach will leave Boise Outlet Mall at 11:30 AM, Thursday January 24th. We'll have pizza on the bus and arrive at the Swiss Village Resort of Zermatt about 6:00 PM.

The first day of skiing and riding will be at Sundance Resort, Friday. The second at Solitude and the third at Brighton. If anyone really wants to ski Deer Valley or Park City at an addition cost, transportation is available.

The trip cost includes a hot buffet breakfast each morning, full use of the resort spa, pools, exercise equipment, and other amenities.

The Sundance Film Festival will be ongoing during our trip and transportation to and from Park City will be available for anyone who wants to join in with the festivities.

This will be a first-class trip with excellent accommodations. We'll have a welcome social Friday evening hosted by the Park City Mountain Sports Club. These folks know how to have a party.

There will be 3 full days on the mountains, returning to Boise Monday afternoon (1:00 PM). I doubt anyone will want to leave. Sunday evening will be an excellent time to be festive in Park City.

The cost is only \$850.00 per person/ double occ. and includes all the porter fees, resort fees and taxes for the resort.

To sum it all up: 3-full days skiing and riding at 3 different resorts, deluxe motor coach (with beverages and pizza dinner,) 4-nights lodging at Zermatt, and a hot breakfast each morning.

Optional activities include a geo-thermal hot pool in a crater, ATV rentals, Park City fun visits, and tours throughout Heber Valley.

I am taking reservations and deposits immediately. The bus has 50 seats so the first to pay a deposit of \$200.00 will get first choice of rooming arrangements as well as choice of bus seating.
