### Timeline:

**Fees:** Opting to abandon sponsored shirts this season.  
U4 through U8 will be \$15, plus purchase of shirt  
U10 and up will be \$30, will reuse fall jerseys

**Schedule:** Proposed 8 week season with 7 games, no games on Memorial Day Weekend.  
U4 – Saturday mornings  
U6/U8 – Sunday afternoons  
U10 and up girls play Saturday  
U10 and up boys play Sunday

### Fields:

Church St - accommodates 3-U4, 2-U6 & 2-U8 fields  
County –1-7v7 (for U10) & 1-9v9 field (for U12 and up)  
Hopkins – practice field for U12 and up. Can be lined for full size if needed

**Fundraising:** Plan is to sell spirit wear via online store with Axelrad. Krispy Kreme donut sales will also take place. WBS Penguins offer a fan appreciation night at no additional cost to the soccer club.

**NEFYSL:** Discussed the potential of leaving EPYSA as our governing body and moving to SAY Soccer. They seemed to be geared more towards recreational soccer and currently represent several teams in Lackawanna County. Registrar states better option as they still utilize Sports Engine instead of Gotsoccer. Referee training has also been offered. Further review of fees and insurance policy is warranted prior to committing to change.

**Finance:** Current balance is \$13,991.41. There is one check issued to NEFYSL for 1557.50 and another to Tom Hamill for \$1383.57 bringing available balance to \$11,050.34.
