WHAT IS SCRIP:

Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that enables families to raise money to put toward their hockey bill. Families purchase gift cards, for stores and restaurants you already visit, pay face value for the gift card, through Scrip, and a percent of your purchase will be credited to your hockey bill (registration fee.) Credit percentages range from 2% up to 20% based on the retailer (see individual retailer for specific details.) Families average a 10% credit, of all gift cards purchased through the program.

There are three different gift card options; eGift cards, Reload, or Physical gift cards. eGift cards allow you to purchase gift cards electronically, on your mobile device or computer, for immediate use. These gift cards can either be printed out or used immediately on your mobile device. Reload adds funds to physical/plastic cards you already have. Physical Gift Cards are the traditional plastic gift cards which are ordered on the first of each month.

GET STARTED:

 Go to www.shopwithscrip.com and select the "join a program" button, located on the launch page on the upper right. You'll then be prompted to enter the JHBC enrollment code which is F623LC9239893. Click the "register" button on the bottom to complete your registration. Enter your player's first and last name as the "student" and your player's level for the "group/classroom." Follow the other prompts as requested. You will be asked to create a "username" and password for login and identification purposes.

When you log in to make your purchases and shop for gift cards, you'll go to the same www.shopwithscrip.com website and click the "login" button instead of the "register." You can also use the "RaiseRight" app on your mobile device, just log in with the same username and password that you set up on the website.

2. If you would like to have access to eGift cards on your mobile devices, you will need to enroll in an Online Payment Option by using your bank account and/or a credit card (Visa, Mastercard & Discover.) Once you register with Scrip, and get your account created, you can add an Online Payment Option. You can find more information and enroll in Online Payment Options from the Dashboard menu.

If you decide to use your bank account for secure debits, you complete the registration. They will make two small credits into your account; you will then log back into your account and enter the amounts that were credited to you. There is a \$0.15 convenience fee for each order (multiple gift cards, for different retailers, can be purchased with each order) for using your bank account and a 2.6% fee for using a credit card.

3. If you choose, there is the RaiseRight app which is the easiest way to purchase and use and track your eGift cards. The app allows you to purchase eGift cards, Reload, use and track balances on your gift cards. This is the most popular choice for JHBC families.

4. Families may share the enrollment code with grandparents, friends and other family so that others can also help raise funds for your player. As long as your player is listed as the "Student" you will get credit for their purchases too.

Money is earned throughout the year and will be credited to your player's account throughout the season. First you will notice an initial credit on your player account, then a mid-season credit in October and a final bill credit mid-March. Credit earned from March until the following season will be credited toward your initial credit at the beginning of the next season.

You always have access to your earnings/credits from the "Reports" tab located within "Family Functions." The report titled Family Order History by Product is the most comprehensive report. Just make sure you have the correct dates for the credit period when you run your report.

No refunds will be given for overpayment. Overpayments will carry over to the following season. Should a family not play in the next season, any unused funds will revert to the association.
