



US LAX EVENTS COVID-19 TOURNAMENT PLAN

Our goal at US Lax Events is to provide a safe and comfortable environment for all attendees this summer while adhering to the recommended CDC guidelines. Teams will witness a different tournament experience than previous years, but it's with the best intentions of overall personal safety and getting back to normalcy. Below are action steps for all US Lax Events tournaments and showcases this summer.

US Lax Events Staff

- All US Lax Events staff will have their temperature taken in the morning before the start of every day of the event in order to work. If temperatures read above the state recommendation, that staff member will be asked to go home.
- All US Lax Events staff members will be required to wear masks in areas of high foot traffic where social distancing is not feasible.

If You Are Sick

- Please stay home if you are not feeling well, have a fever, or have been exposed to COVID-19.
- We highly encourage people who are at higher risk to COVID-19 to stay home.
- Attendees who are displaying COVID symptoms will be asked to leave the event.

Water Availability

- Water will not be available at each field.
- Each team will be required to bring their own water.

Tournament Competition Structure

- Teams will play two games on Saturday and two on Sunday. Some teams will play three games if an exhibition game is needed to round out pool play.
- To limit the number of people on site at once, games will be back to back with a built in break period.
- Until further notice, there will only be two games on Saturday and two on Sunday with no playoffs. This is recommended to limit the number of people on site at once. This will be continuously reviewed as future guidelines are put in place.

Social Distancing Actions

- All attendees should practice social distancing measures when applicable.
- All attendees should bring their own masks and wear when social distancing is not feasible. This is highly encouraged.
- Players, coaches, and officials do not have to wear masks when in competition.
- We strongly encourage teams to carpool to minimize the number of people on site at once.
- Team tents will only be allowed for shade. No tailgating is allowed at the facility or parking lot.
- Spectators sidelines will be marked every 6ft for viewing areas and all spectators must adhere to the 6ft rules.
- In the event of lightning delays, all attendees must seek shelter in their cars and not in the facility buildings.
- Coaches, players, and spectators are highly encouraged not to shake hands or fist bump, therefore handshakes after games are not allowed. Sportsmanship still needs to be exhibited and taken to the highest degree. Cheers or team chants are encouraged if social distancing measures are taken into effect.

Facility

- US Lax Events will work with facility faculty to clean and sanitize high use areas such as bathrooms, door knobs, tables, and water fountains.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at event HQ and each score table.

We are looking forward to being back on the field this summer and restoring normalcy one step at a time. We are determined to provide a safe environment while respecting the current circumstances.
