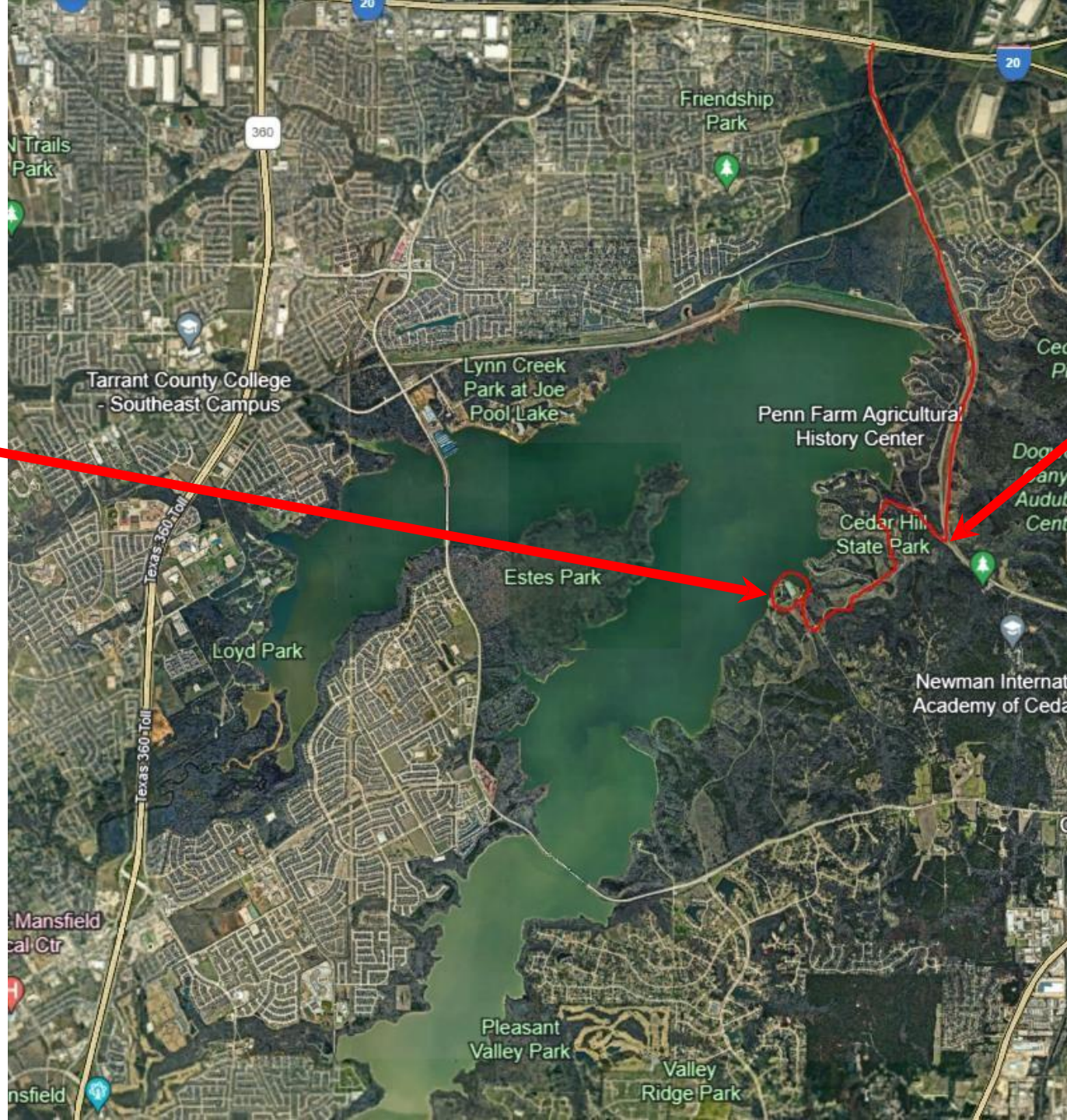

JOE POOL TOURNAMENT INFO

- **Date:** Saturday August 9, 2025
- **Location:** Cedar Hill State Park ([Park Map](#))
- **Ramp:** Cedar Hill State Park South Ramp ([B on this map](#))
- **Fishing Times:** Safe light to 1:00PM ← early due to heat forecast
- **Park Access:**
 - Access Code to Open Gate prior to 6:00AM will be provided to registered boat captains and volunteers
 - All vehicles that enter park prior to park opening must preregister <https://texasstateparks.reserveamerica.com/camping/cedar-hill-state-park/r/deDetails.do?contractCode=TX&parkId=1200114>. To comply with park requirements for early access, please go online in advance and purchase an entrance pass, print and put on the driver's side windshield of your vehicle.
- **Format:** TPWD Handheld Scales, Catch-Weigh-Photo-Release ← also due to heat forecast
 - Bring in each angler's single largest legal (21") fish for photo op if under captains' judgement he can maintain livewell conditions that will keep it healthy. (Note Joe Pool is a slot lake, length limit is a 14-21" slot. Only one bass 21 inches or greater may be retained.)
 - No minimum size limit for this catch/weigh/photo/release format– all bass, regardless of size, can be weighed, captain will total up best 5 on scorecard
- **Morning Check-in and Launch Location:**
 - Check in will be open at 5:00 AM
 - Will pick up TPWD Loaner Scales and Key Fob, Scales will include clipboard, score cards, pen, extra batteries
 - Please be checked in and in the water in advance of safe light (approx. 6:15AM); lower boat numbers stage further from the release jetty
- **Afternoon Check-In and Virtual Weigh-In:**
 - Anglers are not required to fish until 1:00PM to get their score recorded, and can leave at any time so long as they check back in and submit their scorecard before leaving

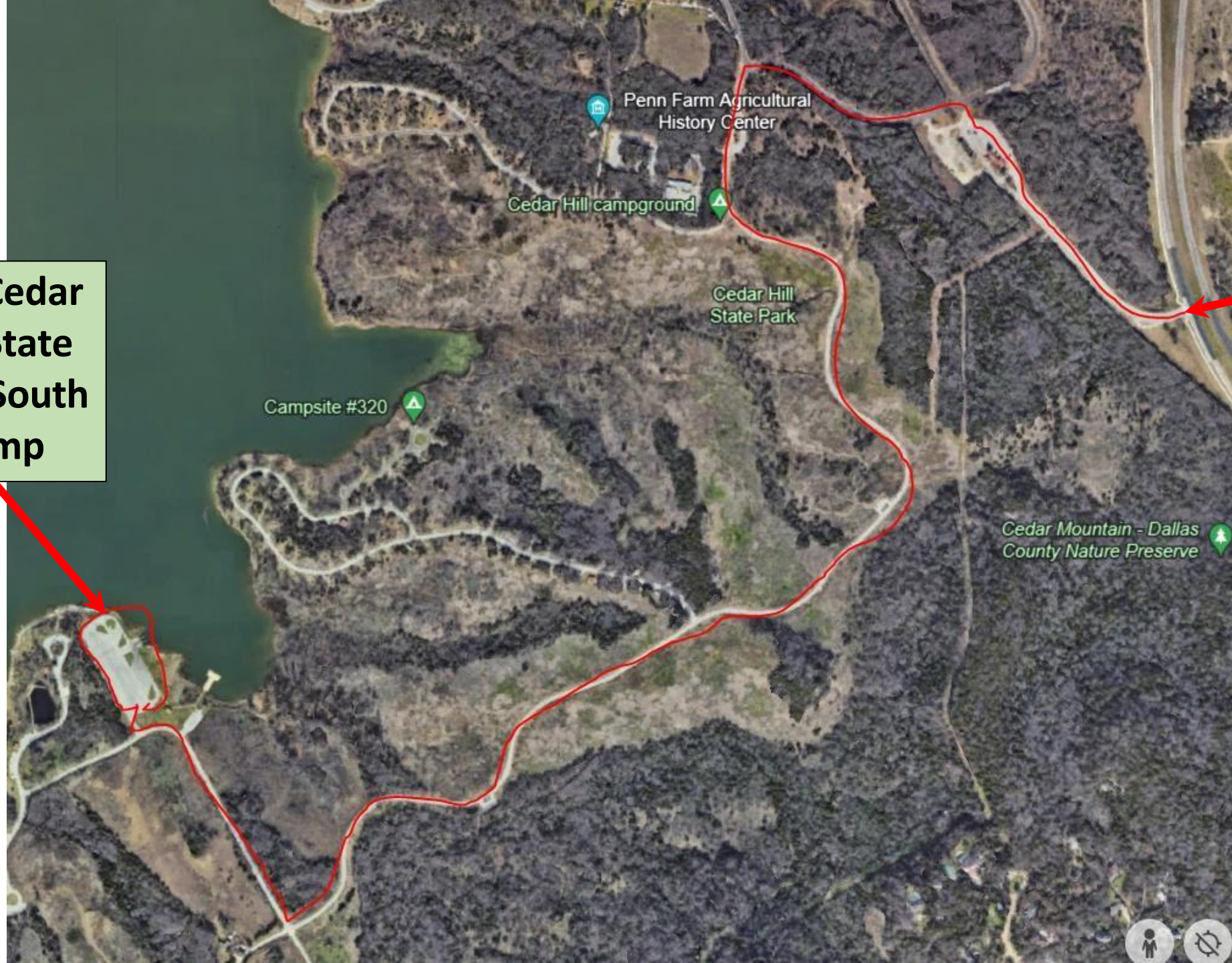

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- For conservation purposes in the extreme heat, we will use TPWD Loaner Brecknell Handheld Scales
- Each fish is to be weighed, photographed, and released
 - Exception – each angler can keep their largest legal fish (21 inches on Joe Pool) in their livewell if within the judgement of the captain the livewell is cool and aerated to provide a safe environment for the bass
- Captains to send pictures to Richard 979-906-1470 during the competition day so he can prepare a slide show for the attendees at weigh-in
 - Picture should include scale readout, at least enough of the fish to identify it as a fish, and if possible the face of the angler
- Check in at LSJrBM trailer by 1:00 by turning in key fob and returning scales.
- Stand in line with weight card and up to 1 fish per angler
- No length limit on bass to be counted; though any single fish brought in must be minimum 21"
- Bank Fisherman will also use these scales for their catch

SCALES

- Each Boat Captain will receive one (1) orange box at morning check-in that contains:
 - Scales
 - Clipboard with two (2) score cards
 - Extra Batteries
 - Pen
- These Brecknell Scales are provided for our use by TPWD Scale Loaner Program and are the same scales used by MLF

SCORECARD

- Circle Age Group
- Fill out Name, Boat #, Date, Lake
- During competition day, as each fish is caught and weighed, write down the DECIMAL weight (3.50lbs, not 3lbs 8oz)
- At the end of the day write top 5 weights in the box on upper right and total them up.
- For proper bookkeeping and accounting, if you zero (don't catch a bass) we still would like you to submit your scorecard with name and zero.
- Angler and Captain both must sign the scorecard to verify the fish they have recorded were caught by the angler

EXERCISE CAUTION AND BE SAFE

- Lake is about .14” below normal pool as of 08/03.
- It will be very hot –
 - Please ensure you pre-hydrate and have enough water for all persons in the boat
 - Wear cool clothing
 - Ice in your livewell will cool the water to hold more oxygen – if you would like to bring in your largest fish for photos
- Get off the water if it gets too hot for you. We should be at the trailer all day to take your scorecard if you need to leave early.
