- III. Boys Basketball update – Corey (5 mins)
  - Tryouts getting going
  - Open gyms on Wednesdays
  
- IV. Playing Up Policy – Kayla (15 mins)
  - Kayla has gathered data from programs around us on what they do.
  - Kayla reached out to all the schools in our conference to understand their playing up policies. Big takeaways from this – needs to be parent consent, needs to be a meeting with the board director and parents, needs board approval.
  - Corey – If it's best for the kids, if it's best for the program, then we should do it.
  - Kayla – Need to create a competitive environment – starts at an early age.
  - Initial thought is they would have to play one year in the program before being considered for playing up.
  - Make it 4<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> grades (instead of just 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades).
    - Keep exact wording on the site but eliminate the grades.
  - Add language that says your grade level is the norm.
  - New policy. Same as current but add 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> (now 4<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup>). Board approval (majority vote). Parent can't coach without board approval (majority vote). In official language, just indicate board approval (don't indicate majority vote). Effective for the 2023-2024 season.
  
- V. Update / action plans for 7th Grade boys and 5th Grade girls travel teams – Dave (10 mins)
  - Need to have a meeting with the parents involved on both teams. Include Kayla/Corey.
  - This meeting should happen after teams are formed.
  - When we send out updates, encourage parents to apply for coaching positions.
  - 7<sup>th</sup> grade group is more concerned about the coaching.

- 5<sup>th</sup> grade group is more concerned about the waiver. Karl to talk to the family.
  - What do we do with waivers going forward?
