Deacon's Message

The Cemetery Committee has been working diligently for over two years to automate the cemetery data so information can be obtained from our website. In 2020, our efforts were curtailed severely by the Covid pandemic. Very little progress was made that year. In 2021, our cemetery maps were sent to be entered into the software being developed for our website. It was determined that our maps were difficult to read, not up-to-date and were not usable. So, the members of the Cemetery Committee, Bob and Sandi Trocinske, Greg and Jan Schild, physically, by hand, measured the Crucifixion and Pine Creek Cemeteries. This took many hours of tedious work. Bob Trocinske then took on the monumental task of drawing new maps to scale which took many hours to complete. Once finished, the new maps were sent to the developer and integrated into the software. We are now in the process of being trained to enter data into the software. Once training is completed, the actual cemetery data will be entered into the software. This, again, will take time to complete. Following the completion of data entry, testing of the system, an announcement will be made when the cemetery maps will be available to the public.
