



## Arvada Hockey /Apex Center Ice Arena

### COVID Procedures

\*updated 2/10/2021

- Players, coaches, spectators, and volunteers agree to stay home if they believe that they may be symptomatic or may have come in contact with someone who may have COVID-19
- All Apex visitors must wear facemasks and maintain appropriate social distancing at all times
- Teams will be allowed in the facility **20 minutes** prior to game time depending on locker room availability
- Teams may use the grassy area and driveway adjacent to the Ice Arena for pre-game warmups
- Two spectators per player will be allowed into the facility. Spectators are allowed to enter the facility 5 minutes before game time and must leave the facility promptly after the game is finished. Spectators are allowed in the bleachers on the second floor only
- No congregating in the lobby area at any time.
- Games are limited to 20 players per team plus 5 additional support staff per team.
- Players are required to wear facemasks in the facility, including in locker rooms
- Coaches/staff are required to wear facemasks at all times, including on the bench
- Coaches will monitor locker rooms at all times to ensure players are wearing facemasks
- Locker room bathrooms and showers are not available at this time
- Locker room doors are to remain open to allow for proper air circulation
- One male and one female bathroom is available in the ice arena lobby and these are designated for players only. Bathrooms for spectators are located on the second level, near the bleachers
- Players must bring their own water bottles - the bottle-fill filler on the lobby water fountain is available for use
- Post contest handshake line is prohibited
- Players need to come dressed in gear except helmet, skates, and gloves prior to entering the facility.
- Live Barn is available at the Apex Center Ice Arena.
