1. Financial Information - Wayne Vance, League Treasurer, presented the financial information from the 2019 and 2020 budget. For more details contact Wayne.
2. 2019 Recap Division Champions
 - a. 22+ Orioles (Adam Clement) Angels (Eric Brooks)
 - b. 35+ Braves (Jeff Wolf)
 - c. 45+ White Sox (Ron Ebelein)
3. Hall of Fame - Jason Tores was elected for 2019. Tad Trias and Steve Hoffman have been tasked to review the HOF criteria and nomination process to identify improvements
4. Misrepresentation of the League - If teams need fields for practice teams should not contact the county or the field manager directly. Requests for practice fields should be made through league officials to request permits from the county. This prevents damage to the relationship the county has with the league.
5. League Fees for 2020 and Due date for final balance (late fees will be applied) Final balance paid through site (April 1). League documents due by April 1. Failure to meet these deadlines will result in late fees, players not being able to play opening day and possibly forfeits. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!** We aren't rescheduling these games if teams owe \$\$\$. League purchased DocuSign, which will be combined into one sheet for each team. Players will electronically sign county roster and the league waiver. This will be set up this week.
6. MSBL medical insurance details and league vote - MSBL national offers team medical insurance which is \$350 per team. Will cover injuries incurred during games. Unanimous NO on the vote.
7. Uniform and Lineup card rules for 2020 - Teams must have jerseys with numbers by opening day. Lineup cards should have full name and number on the card. Players not in uniform will not be allowed to play. (this does not mean the guy that shows up in the red jersey when the team is wearing blue, this applies to mismatched teams and t-shirts with no numbers). **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

- a. League Rules Uniforms 1a. states that teams are required to have similar designed jerseys with numbers. Also MSBL national for it's World Series tournaments, mandates differentiating numbers.
- b. Lineups Rule 4a. Team Managers must provide first and last name and the uniform number of the players in the lineup and as well as all substitute players attending the game. **IT'S ON THE MANAGERS TO MAKE SURE EVERYONE COMPLIES WITH THESE RULES!!!!**
- c. Playoff Eligibility - Players should be on the roster and play in 5 games during the regular season. If teams received a forfeit then everyone receives a game of eligibility.
- 8. League history - league is attempting to beef up website and looking for team pictures to post to show a cumulative history.
- 9. Fields - League requested all fields from last year and in addition Old Mill, Riva, North County and Ft Meade. Glen Burnie should be getting closed for field work beginning June 1. County will turn over and drag Bestgate, Gen Highway and Annapolis. Field Maintenance would include: collecting trash (document issues). Make sure the mound is raked/compacted, tarp mound and home. Escalating fines for teams who don't do post game maintenance.
- 10. Umpire Reviews - Many complaints about umpires, but minimal umpire reviews submitted. Teams need to submit reviews in order to weed out the umpires that are not able to handle the level of competition.
- 11. Website - Permissions have been updated to provide teams with more information such as rosters, schedule
- 12. All Star games - 2019 was cancelled due to lack of players and who was managing. Time and place will be set by July, teams should be submitting players to improve player turnout.
- 13. Tryout and Draft information - March 15 35 and 45 from 11-12, 22 from 12-1. Managers contribute \$20 fee as previous years toward the cage time.
- 14. Opening day (TBD) and baseball pickup at a future date. 2019 T-shirts are dri fit and are delayed. Trophies have been ordered and will be handed out at baseball pickup. 2020 trophies and shirts will be ordered in time to hand out to division champion on the field.
- 15. Question - Date of playoffs? League will announce the start date and our last permit date. Number of games? 21-22 games depending on teams, 35 division should determine the playoff format.
