

## WHY STRIKERS?



- PENFIELD STRIKERS IS THE <u>IDEAL SOCCER OPTION</u> FOR GIRLS WHO LOVE THE GAME AND WOULD LIKE TO PLAY AT AN <u>ADVANCED LEVEL AT AN AFFORDABLE COST</u>. ANNUALLY, STRIKERS PLAYERS BENEFIT FROM:
  - Regular <u>practices weekly</u> from November through July, facilitated by a dedicated coaching staff
  - A full <u>RDYSL</u> league schedule: 12 games from mid-May thru 1st week of August
    - There are **6 home games and 6 away games** (within Monroe and surrounding counties)
  - Team monies that may be used to support **2-3 tournaments** (typically 3-4 games per Fri-Sun tournament)
  - Skills training with Craig Demmin from November to April (frequency varies for older age groups)
  - Extra team practices at Penfield Central Schools and other facilities
  - Opportunities to engage in <u>community service and social activities</u>
  - <u>Leadership & volunteer opportunities for U13+ girls</u> to be volunteer coaches and referees in our fall All Girls All Soccer (AGAS) program
  - We have a well-established <u>scholarship program</u> benefitting two deserving players each year



## COACHING COMMITTEE



The Strikers, working in association with Craig Demmin, follow the U.S. Soccer's New Player Development Initiatives.

This focuses on developing players with more individual skill, intelligence, creativity and confidence on the field.

It does not always reflect in wins but does create a better individual product that strengthens the girls play as they mature.

This supports the Strikers mission of giving girls an opportunity to play at the higher levels of competition and being successful.

## CRAIG DEMMIN SOCCER



Craig Demmin has over 12 years experience as a professional soccer player. He is a former Rochester Raging Rhinos team captain and four-time team MVP. Craig has accrued over 35 caps for the Trinidad & Tobago National Team.

His additional playing experience includes: East Fife Football Club, Scotland; Tampa Bay Mutiny, MLS; Virginia Beach Mariners and Jackson Chargers. Craig holds a Class A USSF coaching license.

He has an extensive coaching background and has worked with individual players and local college teams, including players in the Major League Soccer, US Men's National Team, Trinidad and Tobago National Team, and Monroe Community College.





## PRINCIPLES OF DEVELOPMENT



## Basic: Ages U9 through U12

- At ages 9 through 12 players have the special ability to learn and grow as an individual. Focus is now turned developing players more towards their "techniques" and "skills" repetitive touches and fundamentals
- Stresses individual foot skills, passing & simple 1v1 and 2v1 drills
- The later stages as players continue to develop this transitions into small sided games, combination play and things such as shooting.
- Position focus is open and players share responsibilities on the field
- Speed, coordination, balance and agility take a bigger presence in practices
- # of Field Players:
  - U9/10 = 7v7
  - U11/12 = 9v9

## PRINCIPLES OF DEVELOPMENT



# Intermediate: Ages U13 and U14

- Players are now focused on tactics, movement and playing in bigger spaces – introduction of full field games
  - U13+ = 11v11
- More emphasis now placed on strength, flexibility and endurance in training while stressing importance of warm-ups and warmdowns – FIFA Warm-ups
- The later stages as players continue to develop this transitions into small sided games, combination play and things such as shooting.
- Develop discipline and following instructions from coaching

## PRINCIPLES OF DEVELOPMENT



## Advanced: Ages U15 to U18

- Tactical training and small sided competitive games stressing attacking and defending principles that are part of competitions
- Speed of play, quick transitions, counter attacking, pressure and finishing area of specific focus
- Technique incorporates speed, precision, and positioning
- Competitive aspects of finishing and players position responsibilities are being strengthened and reinforced in training
- Position roles are well defined including defensive passing from the back, central midfield play, and strikers receiving the ball and turning to finish
- Players at this time are committed to programs and competition phases of the game







- Need emphasis on feeder programs to boost numbers (AGAS and LBs)
- Strong coaching and fun environment is critical to future team success

# <u>U12 – U15/16 is historically a challenging</u> period for teams:

- Game Size Increase (i.e. 9v9 to 11v11)
- Increased competitive environment (more girls move to other clubs/Thruway league/Academy)
- Many girls decide to pursue other interests

## **EXECUTIVE BOARD POSITIONS**



- PRESIDENT: THIS POSITION IS A PART OF THE BOARD EXECUTIVE TEAM AND IS
  RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DAY-TO-DAY GOVERNANCE OF THE CLUB, IS THE TEAM
  REPRESENTATIVE TO THE LEAGUE, AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ATTENDING LEAGUE
  MEETINGS. THE PRESIDENT PRESIDES AT MEETINGS, SET AGENDAS, AND CREATE
  COMMITTEES.
- VICE PRESIDENT (2): THIS POSITION IS A PART OF THE BOARD EXECUTIVE TEAM AND IS
  RESPONSIBLE FOR ASSISTING THE PRESIDENT IN THE GOVERNANCE OF THE CLUB. THE
  VP STANDS IN WHEN THE PRESIDENT IS ABSENT.
  - The First Vice-President is the senior Vice President and shall perform the duties of the President in his/her absence, and shall also perform such other duties as are usual to the office or as requested by the President. He/she shall supervise the Board elections at the Annual Meeting and serve as the chair of the Nominating Committee.
  - The Second Vice-President is the junior Vice President and shall perform the duties of the First Vice-President in his/her absence, and shall also perform such other duties as are usual to the office or as requested by the President and First Vice President.
- TREASURER: RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DAY-TO-DAY FINANCES OF THE CLUB (TRACKING PAYMENTS, MAKING DEPOSITS, PAYING BILLS), MONTHLY BALANCE SHEET AND INCOME SHEET PREPARATION AS WELL AS AN ANNUAL BUDGET UTILIZING QUICKBOOKS. (TAX PREPARATION IS HANDLED BY A THIRD PARTY AND NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TREASURER)
- SECRETARY: THIS POSITION IS A PART OF THE BOARD EXECUTIVE TEAM AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TAKING ATTENDANCE AT EACH BOARD MEETING, RECORDING MINUTES OF EACH MEETING TO BE PROVIDED TO THE BOARD, AND PARTICIPATE IN SUBCOMMITTEES WHERE NEEDED.

## MEMBERS-AT-LARGE

- REGISTRAR: RESPONSIBLE FOR TRACKING ANNUAL REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS, INPUTTING PLAYER INFORMATION TO THE LEAGUE, RECEIVING AND DISTRIBUTING PLAYER PASSES AND ADULT RISK MANAGEMENT PASSES TO THE TEAMS, COORDINATING AND TRACKING RISK MANAGEMENT TRAINING
- FIELD COORDINATOR: RESPONSIBLE FOR SCHEDULING FIELDS FOR INDOOR PRACTICE
  AND OUTDOOR GAMES. YOU WILL BE THE CLUB LIAISON WITH THE TOWN ABOUT FIELDS.
  COMMUNICATE AND COORDINATE WITH THE RANGERS CLUB PERTAINING TO FIELDS.
- FUNDRAISER COORDINATOR: RESPONSIBLE FOR DEVELOPING CLUB FUNDRAISER IDEAS AND WORKING WITH TEAM COACHES AND MANAGERS FOR THOSE FUNDRAISING EFFORTS. YOU MAY WORK WITH THE COMMUNITY TO SOLICIT DONATIONS TOWARDS FUNDRAISING EFFORTS.
- <u>UNIFORM COORDINATOR:</u> RESPONSIBLE FOR RESEARCHING COMPANIES FOR UNIFORM ITEMS AND PRICING. YOU WILL COMMUNICATE WITH THE CLUB ABOUT UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS, COORDINATE A UNIFORM FITTING AND ORDER, AND TRACK PAYMENTS AND DISTRIBUTIONS OF UNIFORMS. YOU ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR ARRANGING SPIRIT WEAR ORDERS 2 3 TIMES PER YEAR.
- EQUIPMENT COORDINATOR: RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING ANY EQUIPMENT NECESSARY FOR EACH TEAM (BENCHES, GAME BALLS, CONES, ICE PACKS, ETC). MAINTAIN SUPPLY OF YARD SIGNS AND PINNIES FOR TRYOUTS. MAINTAIN THE SHEDS AT EACH FIELD LOCATION. ORDER SUPPLIES AS NEEDED. COORDINATE WITH THE FIELD COORDINATOR TO HANG GOAL NETS BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF EACH SEASON.

## MEMBERS-AT-LARGE



- LITTLE BOLTS COORDINATOR: RESPONSIBLE FOR RUNNING TWO SESSIONS PER YEAR FALL AND SPRING. YOU WILL SECURE ASSISTANT COACHES, COMMUNICATE WITH PARENTS, ORDER SHIRTS, AND PLAN WEEKLY SOCCER RELATED ACTIVITIES FOR THE YOUNG PLAYERS. YOU WILL COACH EACH SESSION AND SERVE AS A STEPPING STONE TO STRIKERS OR RANGERS AS AGE PERMITS.
- ALL GIRLS ALL SOCCER COORDINATOR: RESPONSIBLE FOR COORDINATING THE FALL RECREATIONAL PROGRAM FOR THE CLUB. INCLUDING OVERSEEING REGISTRATION, PAYMENT, TEAM ASSIGNMENTS, COACH ASSIGNMENTS, AND T-SHIRT ORDERS. YOU WILL BE THE ONSITE CONTACT ON GAME DAYS TO ENSURE SMOOTH PLAY.
- SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE COORDINATOR: LIAISON WITH THE PENFIELD HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR YEARLY ON SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION. COMMUNICATE OUT TO THE CLUB AND FORMER U17-U19 TEAMS AS DEADLINE APPROACHES EACH YEAR. REVIEW APPLICANTS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP AND WITH THE OTHER COMMITTEE MEMBERS SELECT A WINNER FOR EACH OF THE TWO SCHOLARSHIPS. PRESENT WINNERS TO THE BOARD AND PREPARE NOTIFICATION LETTER & AWARDS FOR EACH WINNER.
- PHOTO COORDINATOR: SECURE PHOTOGRAPHER TO TAKE PICTURES OF THE PLAYERS
  ONCE PER YEAR. HAVE ANY CONTACT APPROVED BY THE BOARD BEFORE ACCEPTING IT.
  SET DATE/DAYS FOR PICTURES TO BE TAKEN AFTER UNIFORMS ARRIVE FOR SEASON &
  COORDINATE TEAM TIMES WITH COACHES & MANAGERS ON THE PICTURE TIMES. ASSIST
  ON PHOTO DAY AND DELIVERY OF PHOTOS.
- PUBLIC RELATIONS COORDINATOR: SUBMITTING ADS TO PENFIELD RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE MAILINGS AND WITH ANY OF THE LOCAL SCHOOLS. MAINTAIN SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOUNTS.

## MEMBERS-AT-LARGE



- TRYOUT COMMITTEE COORDINATOR: RESPONSIBLE FOR SCHEDULING TRY-OUTS.
   COORDINATING TRY-OUT ASSISTANTS. COMPILING TRY-OUT RESULTS AND PROVIDING TEAM ROSTERING INFORMATION TO THE PRESIDENT AND COACHES. PREP REGISTRATION FOLDERS, STAFF CHECK IN STATIONS DURING TRY OUTS, STAFF PAPERWORK TABLE AT ANNUAL MEETING.
- <u>HEAD MANAGER:</u> RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING GUIDANCE AND SUPPORT FOR ALL NEW TEAM MANAGERS. PROMOTING PROCESSES AND INSTRUCTING STEPS FOR GENERAL MANAGER DUTIES.
- <u>WEBMASTER:</u> RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING AND UPDATING STRIKERS WEBPAGE AND WEBPAGE CONTENT. OPENS REGISTRATIONS AS NEEDED FOR GENERAL, AGAS, AND LITTLE BOLTS.

## STANDING COMMITEES



- <u>COACHING COMMITTEE:</u> PROVIDES GUIDANCE TO STRIKERS COACHES THROUGHOUT THE SEASON. OFFER COACHING ADVICE, DEVELOP TRAINING SUPPORT, AND HOLDS ANNUAL COACHES MEETING TO HELP ORIENT COACHES FOR START OF PRACTICE SEASON.
- SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE: LIAISON WITH THE PENFIELD HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR YEARLY ON SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION. COMMUNICATE OUT TO THE CLUB AND FORMER U17-U19 TEAMS AS DEADLINE APPROACHES EACH YEAR. REVIEW APPLICANTS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP AND WITH THE OTHER COMMITTEE MEMBERS SELECT A WINNER FOR EACH OF THE TWO SCHOLARSHIPS. PRESENT WINNERS TO THE BOARD AND PREPARE NOTIFICATION LETTER & AWARDS FOR EACH WINNER.
- TRY-OUT COMMITTEE: SUPPORTS TRY-OUT COMMITTEE CHAIR IN THE EXECUTION OF ANNUAL TRY-OUTS. PARTICIPATES IN TEAM ROSTERING DECISIONS AND PLAYER OFFERS.
- SPECIAL COMMITEES: COMMITEES REQUESTED BY THE PRESIDENT/BOARD DETERMINED ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS AND IN SUPPORT OF OFF-NOMINAL ACTIVITIES.
