

Studio Opening Update

Endeavor's physical studio will remain closed until Phase 3 and the Orange County stay at home order is lifted. During Phase 2 all indoor business are ordered closed. During this phase, we will hold outdoor, socially distant classes. We will continue to keep everyone updated as things progress.

Endeavor NEW Studio Policies

New policies will be implemented immediately upon reopening.

- Endeavor will comply with all state, county, and local rules regarding social distancing and sanitation as outlined by the California Department of Public Health and OCgov.com.
- 2. Students, faculty, staff, and families that are sick should stay home. You should remain home until you are fever free for at least 72 hours without fever reducing medication.
- 3. If you travel out of the country, please do not attend the studio for 2 weeks after you return or test negative for COVID-19.
- 4. Students, faculty, and staff who complain of illness will have their temperature taken and sent home if they have a fever and/or display any respiratory infection symptoms such as coughing or difficulty breathing.
- 5. Students who show symptoms will be separated from staff and others until they can be picked up.
- 6. Hand sanitizer stations will be available at the entry doors and inside each studio. Students and adults dropping them off should use sanitizer upon entering and exiting the building.
- 7. All students and parents will be given a temperature check upon entering.
- 8. We will be limiting the number on non-dancers (parents, siblings, etc.) in the parent lounge, lobby, and café in order to protect our dancers, parents, and staff. Parents of tiny tot dancers are asked to provide a cell phone number and wait in the parking lot. An instructor will text you should your child need your assistance.
- 9. Students will be assigned an entrance door and should wait outside until the instructor opens the door. Dancers must proceed directly to their assigned studio and may not use the locker room or study room.
- 10. Dancers should arrive with their dance bag (including all necessary shoes) and water.
- 11. Classrooms will be re-engineered in order to maintain social distance guidelines.
- 12. Endeavor will no longer provide water from stand-alone dispensers. Every student should bring their own labeled water bottle to class. Endeavor will continue to sell water in the front office.

- 13. Class water breaks will be taken inside each classroom to reduce the number of students in the lobby and café.
- 14. Classroom activities will be modified to maximize social distancing between students and faculty. We are so sorry but please let your dancer know that hugs, high fives, or any other type of physical contact will be prohibited between teachers, staff, and students.
- 15. Faculty and staff will be wearing protective masks as recommended by the Orange County health officials. Students and parents are asked to comply with all recommendations of public health officials.
- 16. All classroom props, ballet barres, furniture, and surface areas have been thoroughly sanitized prior to opening. ESA Staff and the hired cleaning crew will continue to clean and sanitize public areas throughout the day.
- 17. Classes will also be available via Zoom for any families that prefer to take class online or for parents that would like to watch class.
- 18. Endeavor procedures will be modified at the recommendation of the Orange County Public Health Officials.
