To: Board of Directors of Baseball British Columbia Amateur Association.

Dear Sirs,

As you are aware, we have encountered issues with this Provincial Sport Organization (PSO) for the past several months. Based on our concerns we have had two meetings with all our Association Members present, one at our A.G.M. November 15, 2014 and an additional meeting this past Sunday February 15, 2015.

We have reached out to Baseball B.C. to resolve these matters but based on the correspondence we have received it does not appear that we will be able to reach a mutual agreement on the way we wish to conduct baseball activities within our Province. As a result B.C. (Minor) Baseball believes that service to our members is been compromised. Therefore we have decided it is in our best interest to sever our affiliation relationship with Baseball B.C. effective March 31,2015 midnight.

B.C. (Minor) Baseball will continue to support all current Baseball Canada National programming (NCCP, Rally Cap, Grand Slam and Winter Ball for example) on the condition they manage through the PSO which is already in place for 2015. We have advised all of our Association Members of this decision to withdraw and ask that you please ensure that all your members are also made aware of this.

As part of this separation we would request from Baseball B.C. the \$1.00 per registered player of B.C. (Minor) Baseball for a total of \$14,075.00. We also request all gaming and block funding owed to our Association. We estimate on a three year average money's received from the Gaming Branch on behalf of B.C. (Minor) Baseball would be \$100,000.00. These funds have already been received by the PSO on behalf of Baseball B.C. according to Provincial records.

Thank-you for your assistance in the above matters.
