Girls Varsity Head Coach Job Description

Job Summary

The Girls Varsity Head Coach is responsible for providing leadership, guidance and instruction to student athletes within the program. The head coach reports to, and works closely with, the Girls High School Director, Girls Coaching Director and Girls Youth Director to determine the goals and direction of the girls program to build the program from youth through high school. Additionally, the head coach works with the Boys Varsity Head coach to further the Mukwonago Lacrosse Club program as “one club.” The head coach is responsible for the health, safety and welfare of every student athlete participating on the team.

- Maintain a proper relationship with athletes and parents
- Assist the Girls High School Director in postseason reporting, awards/recognition protocols, and picnic/ planning as needed
- Actively recruits at the youth, middle school and high school levels

- Participates in required USA Lacrosse training and education
- Participates in off-season clinics, camps and program activities as recommended by the Girls Coaching Director
- Other duties as assigned
