



Borrowing a Player

Borrowing a player:

If a team will drop below 10 players for a game, they are allowed to bring a player to a game after following the below procedure:

Notify the opposing manager through email that you will be using a non-rostered player (24 hours notice). Provide the opponent with the Players Name, Birth Date and Number he will wear. The MSBL Coordinators only need to be notified if there is an issue.

Examples of acceptable non-rostered player substitutions:

A League- You may call up a player from a B Level team, call up a player from the age level below either A or B Level, or use a house player B League- You may call up a player from the age level below either A or B Level, or use a house player.

Rosters are locked for the season on March 31, 2019. Should a team have an extreme circumstance a player can possibly be added. This is only done on a case by case basis and would have to be considered by the MSBL Coordinators.







MSBL Tournament Rules

Any ties entering the tournament (Regular Season) will result in the following: 1) Head to Head 2) Runs Allowed 3) Coin Toss

Any ties entering the single elimination will result in the following: 1) Record 2) Runs Allowed 3) Higher Seeded Team in Tournament

Games are scheduled for 6 innings in length, but may be shorter because of the time limit. Game time limit is one hour and forty-five minutes; no inning will start after that time, but the bottom half of an inning may be played, if the home team trails the visiting team. The tournament director may determine completion time in questionable circumstances. Some rescheduling may be required in the event unfinished games are causing a backlog on the fields.

For elimination round games, if the score is tied after the 6th inning, the Speed-Up Rule will apply. The Speed-Up Rule will be based on California rules: for each half inning played beyond the 6th inning, the inning will begin with one out and one runner on second base (the last player called out in the previous inning will be the base runner).

There is no time limit, and consequently no speed-up rule, for the Championship games. Though slaughter rules will still be in effect.

Umpires and tournament officials will keep the official game time.



MSBL Tournament Rules

Pitching Restrictions:

- 2 Innings per game
- 4 Innings per day*
- 7 Innings per tournament



*Should weather dictate that teams play more than two games in a day, the Tournament Director reserves the right to modify the per-day innings maximum.

- Submit your completed scheduling sheet back to your table. Please
 <u>DO NOT</u> leave. The MSBL staff will need to proof your scheduling
 sheet for accuracy. Any questions, we will call out your team name
 and/or your name.
- 3. Make payment at Table "B" (if you have not done so already). Pick up the Official MSBL Roster Sheet (please submit official online).
- 4. Enjoy some food and drinks while socializing with your fellow 10U coaches.
- 5. Once the MSBL staff has checked your scheduling sheet for accuracy, you will be free to leave. We will notify you when we have checked your data. Please **Do Not** leave until we have confirmed everything. This makes the process easier for the MSBL staff.
