Dear Baseball Parents;

Beginning Wednesday, July 1, Seminole County has issued a mandate requiring face masks for all, the City must now require all who enter our buildings and athletic facilities to wear a mask when in public. This mandate does not pertain to youth during fitness and athletics.

Our requirement for baseball will be for players, coaches and administrators to wear a mask as they enter the ballpark and when they are in the dugout unless they are able to social distance themselves from teammates (we have expanded dugouts to allow for social distancing). Players are not required to wear a mask during play on the field. Since coaches are not involved in the athletic portion of the game they will be required to wear a mask anytime they cannot social distance from other coaches, players and fans.

Fans should wear a mask unless they are able to social distance from other fans, coaches and players. We appreciate the positive response from those who have continued to allow their children to participate in this worthwhile activity and are open to speak with you regarding this or any other aspect of the baseball league.
