- -Courtney is checking on a U10 scheduler. Appears that Dave may be doing the scheduling for other teams in the northern league.
- -Almost all age groups have coaches on the girl's side. Boys teams are light on coaches. Need many team managers still at this point. Should start to fill in as we get closer to the

season. Need a concerted effort to recruit more coaches for next summer. Any potential coach's names should be sent to Courtney.

-Noel will work with Courtney on sending out a reminder within school e-newsletters for summer soccer programs.

## **VIII.Summer Soccer Camp Updates**

- -Dan Weiler's Camp is online for registration and dates are set.
- -NDSU camp for older players will be discussed with Courtney in upcoming weeks. Proposed camp would be \$100 for kids 13-18. Focus on finishing and goaltending potentially.

## **IX.Indoor Winter Programs Updates**

- -Increasing ages to 14 for futsal appears to have been a good move according to coordinator.
- -There is some aggressive play during futsal. Board members will have a discussion with those teams identified as being too aggressive to let them know they are being watched. Continued aggressive behavior will result in a referee being brought in with a cost to the team.
- -Board decided we will open registration to new players that are coming in late in the season in order to build teams with short numbers.
- -Joy is suggesting that the board reaches out to neighboring communities and businesses next year to help build up the teams for next year.
- -We need a roster from Courtney for futsal with dates of registration, if possible.
- -T-shirts still need to be ordered.
- -Futsal coordinator should likely have access to SportsEngine in order to have access to all the roster information.
- -For next year maybe we can have someone from the board available to collect money at the first couple of Sundays of futsal to ensure sign-ups.
- -Joy is suggesting that we remove the co-ed rule for next year. Finding girls for teams is problematic.
- -Teams would like updates on scoring throughout the season. Suggested Andy or Joy send out updates to captains.

Adam motioned for closing. Henry second. None opposed. Meeting ends 8:15pm
