

## **NWBA Position Description**

**Title:** Head Coach – U.S. Men’s Under 23 National Team

**Reports to:** NWBA High Performance Committee

**Basic Function:** Responsible for the overall planning, management and operation of all aspects of the U.S. Men’s Under 23 National Team, in accordance with NWBA Policies and Procedures.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Citizen of the United States of American
- Current member of the NWBA (for 2021-22 season; entry as a Non-Athlete Member/Registration)
- Current coach of a recognized NWBA team, with a minimum of five years of coaching experience
- Prior success coaching in NWBA post season (e.g. Junior, Collegiate, Men’s or Women’s), demonstrated by appearances in divisional final four
- Successful completion of the American Sports Education Program (ASEP) Coaching Program
- Ability to commit to a two year appointment (part-time)
- Interest in coaching a Men’s or Women’s Senior National Team in the future

### **Preferred Qualifications:**

- Demonstrated ability to coach, teach and manage at the international level
- Prior National Team coaching experience as a first or second assistant coach
- Experience in international player selection process
- Working knowledge of IWBFB classification, rules, and officiating
- Proven ability to manage conflict or crisis
- Bachelor’s degree from an accredited university/college

### **Characteristic Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Directly responsible for planning, administering, developing, coordinating and coaching the U.S. Men’s Under 23 National Team in selection, development, training and competition events, in adherence to the NWBA Code of Conduct
- Directly responsible for recruiting, training, and developing a staff to support the U.S. Men’s Under 23 National Team
- Directly responsible for promoting and administering a fair, ethical and safe environment for all players and staff
- Directly responsible for developing and executing a practice and competition strategy that will produce a medal
- Directly responsible for managing budget in a manner that achieves both optimal performance and fiduciary responsibility, in accordance with NWBA Policies and Procedures
- Directly leads a staff member who is responsible for organizing, and maintaining all team equipment
- Directly leads a staff member who is responsible for organizing, maintaining and reporting all team participation information and statistics
- Directly leads a staff member who is responsible for scheduling and coordinating all team events
- Directly responsible for the USA team representing and promoting the NWBA, USA Basketball, USOPC and the IWBFB in a positive and professional manner at all times
- Performs other duties as assigned by the NWBA High Performance Committee that support the mission and needs of the U.S. Men’s Under 23 National Team and the NWBA
