2021 NL GIRLS PROVINCIAL TEAM TRYOUT INFORMATION

Although the Baseball Canada National Championships are cancelled again this year, Baseball NL is working with the other Atlantic Provinces to organize High Performance replacement events for a number of teams and programs, including NL Girls Baseball at 14U, 16U, and 21U. These potential events along with other NL Girls Provincial Team Programming will be contingent on Public Health guidelines and travel within the Atlantic Region.

We strongly encourages all female athletes in the province who have an interest and are eligible for the NL Girls High Performance Teams to tryout. We also encourage all female athletes to participate in training programs in their respective regions prior to the identification and selection process for the NL Girls Provincial Teams.

Provincial Teams

14U*	Maximum of 14 players, which can include up to two overage (2006) players.

16U**	Maximum of 18 players, which can include up to three overage (2004) players.
21U***	Maximum of 18 players

* Players selected to the 14U teams should plan to attend the 14U Atlantic Event in Nova Scotia (Sep 10 - 12).

** Players selected to the 16U team should plan to attend a Final Team Preparation camp in St. John's (Aug 23 – 25) and the replacement 16U Atlantic Event in Summerside, PEI (Aug 26 - 30).

*** Players selected to the 21U team should plan to attend a Final Team Preparation camp in St. John's (Aug 9 – 11) and the replacement 21U Atlantic Event in St. John's, NL (Aug 12 - 15).

Tryout Process

Players will attend regional ID and evaluation camps. Players are required to register online for the regional ID camps by completing the BNL "Provincial Teams Tryout Registration Form" online at www.nlgirlsbaseball.com by **Monday May 10, 2021**.

Cost of the regional ID and evaluation camps will be **\$60.00** and can be paid at any time prior to the camp. Email money transfer to nlgirlsbaseball@gmail.com is preferred but alternate payment arrangements can be made by contacting Michelle Healy (michellemhealy74@gmail.com).

All players will be provided with an electronic evaluation report as part of the regional ID and evaluation camp.

Any player attending a regional ID and evaluation camp and is interested in being evaluated for multiple teams (14U/16U/21U) will only have to pay the \$60.00 fee once.
