



Marty Lang was one of the premier foil fencers in American fencing history. Marty was the 1975 Pan American Games Champion and won 6 National Championship Gold Medals. In 1976 Marty was a member of the US Olympic Foil Team.

Marty is a 2012 inductee into the NYU Athletic Hall of Fame. As the NCAA Silver Medalist in 1972, Marty was a First Team All American Foil Fencer.



One of the most highly regarded foil officials, Marty received his International Foil Officiating License in 1970 and has officiated multiple National and International Foil Events, actually being requested to officiate at the 1984 Olympic Games.

Marty's passion for the game came from his two legendary coaches, Georgio Santelli and Csaba Elthes. Marty founded the Lang Fencing Academy in Tennessee where he has continued to impart his unequalled knowledge and skill to generations of fencers.
