# **DIRECTIONS TO TRAVEL FIELDS - 2014**

# <u>Cheyenne - Coke Gonzales (MLK Park), Lions Park, and Lansing Field, CJL</u>

#### Coke Gonzales (MLK Park) -

o North on I-25 into Cheyenne. Exit East on Missile Drive Exit (Exit 10). Continue traveling East on Missile Drive (approximately .7 miles) and you will go under some railroad tracks. The next left after the tracks is 19<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn East on 19<sup>th</sup> Street and the fields are on your right approximately 1 block.

#### Pioneer Park-

o I-25 north to Cheyenne to Exit 11 (Randall Exit) turn East, go 2 blocks to Cribbon, turn South, go 3 blocks to Talbot, turn west on Talbot, go one block and Pioneer Park is on the left.

#### Lansing and Dutcher Fields -

O North on I-25 into Cheyenne. Continue north until you come to the Pershing Blvd. and FE Warren Main Gate Exit. Take the exit down to the stop light and bear 45 degrees to the right onto Pershing Blvd. Travel approximately 4-5 miles until you come to Converse Avenue. Turn left on Converse Avenue heading North until you come to the Dutcher Complex on your left (second complex). Enter the complex and Lansing Field will be the first field on your right. The Dutcher Fields will be the second two fields to the West.

#### Lions: Lions Park – Dunbar Field

o From I-25 heading north, take Central Ave. exit (Exit 12). Turn right onto Central Avenue and head southeast .5 miles. Turn right onto Kennedy Rd. and go 1 block, turn left onto Carey Ave. (heading south) and go .3 miles. Turn left on S. Lions Park Drive. Go past Cheyenne Botanical Gardens into Lions Park. Field is on the left.

#### Pride East -

o Take I-25 N. to I-80 E. Exit on N. College Drive to E. 12th Street, Take a left on E. 12th Street (you will be heading West), E.12th Street will turn into Nationway and Stay in left lane until you come to a stop light with intersecting street of Nationway and Windmill. At that stop light take a left to the service road and you will see Kia of Cheyenne and VFW, Pride Ball Park is behind VFW

#### CJL: Cheyenne Junior League

O Take I-25 north to Exit 12 (Central Ave); Turn right on Central street. Go to east to Yellowstone Ave. Turn left onto Yellowstone. Travel 0.2 miles and take first right onto Dell Range Blvd. Travel East 2.3 miles and turn right onto Converse Ave. Go to top of first hill and turn left into parking lot on East side of Converse Ave. South fields are the first set of 3 fields in complex.

#### Fort Collins –

### *City Park North* – 1500 West Mulberry, by the Baseball Office

o I-25 to Mulberry (Hwy14) Exit. Exit West on Mulberry to Shields St. North on Shields (approx. 4 blocks) to Oak St. West on Oak St until Oak dead-ends into baseball field parking lot.

#### *Edora Park East and West* – 1420 E Stuart

o I-25 to Prospect Road Exit. Exit West on prospect to Lemay Avenue. South on Lemay to Stuart St. East on Stuart (approx. 34 mile) to fields on the left.

#### Fossil Creek East and West: 1521 E. Lemay

I -25 to Harmony Exit: Harmony west to Lemay Avenue. South on Lemay to Fossil Creek Park. Park will be on the west side of Lemay.

### Greenbriar Park East and West 730 Willox

o I-25 to Mulberry (Hwy14) Exit. Exit West to Lemay Avenue. North on Lemay to Willox St. West on Willox and the fields will be on your right.

**Landings:** 4351 Boardwalk

o I-25 to Harmony Exit, west on Harmony to Boardwalk Drive. Head north (R) and follow Board to the field. Field will be on left side of Boardwalk.

#### Lee Martinez East and West: 600 N. Sherwood

o I-25 to Mulberry (Hwy14) Exit. Exit West on Mulberry to College Avenue, Head North on College to Cherry Street, Head West on Cherry St about 4 blocks to Sherwood, head North on Sherwood into the Park.

# Spring CANYON Park: 2626 W. Horsetooth

o From I-25, Take the Harmony Rd./CO – 68 exit 265, From Harmony Rd. turn right onto Taft Hill Road, and head North to Horsetooth Road (1mile). Head West on Horsetooth to the end of the road, turn into the park on the Right and the fields are to the left across from the dog park.

#### Spring Park East and West 2100 Mathews

o From I-25, Take the Harmony Rd./CO – 68 exit 265. Turn west onto Harmony Rd. From Harmony Rd. turn right onto S. College Ave. / US-287 N. Take College Ave South to Stuart Street, turn right and head east on Stuart to Busch Court. (This is right past Mountain Gymnastics). Curve around to the ball fields.

## Warren Park – 1101 E. Horsetooth

o I-25 to Harmony Road Exit. Exit West on Harmony to Timberline. North on Timberline to Horsetooth Rd. West on Horsetooth to Lemay. Field on left at intersection of Horsetooth and Lemay.

#### Walker Field: at Lincoln Middle School 1600 Lancer Drive

 I -25 to Shields, N on Shields to Vine, West on Vine to Lancer Drive, Horseshoe road and field is behind the Boys & Girls Club.

# **Greeley – Greeley Youth Sports Complex and Forbes Field**

Youth Sports Complex (South Red, South Blue, South Yellow, South Green, North Yellow, North Red, and North Green) -

o I-25 to Hwy 34 Exit. Continue on 34 bypass. Just before entering Greeley, turn North on 65<sup>th</sup> Ave. 65<sup>th</sup> turns into 59<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Take 59<sup>th</sup> Ave. to 20<sup>th</sup> St. and turn left. Complex ½ mile down on the right side.

## Longmont – Sandstone Park, Kimball Field, and Clark-Centennial Rodriguez Complex

#### Sandstone Park –

o I-25 to Hwy 119 (Exit #240) West on Hwy 119 approximately 3 miles. Complex is on the South side of Hwy 119

# <u>Clark-Centennial Complex (Kimble NE, Draper SE, Montgomery SW Rodriguez SE)</u> –

Take I-25 to exit 243 toward Longmont/Lyons. Turn right on to CO-66/CR-30. Take a left onto Pace St.
Take a right onto E. Mountain View Ave. take a left onto Alpine St. Kimball, Draper & Montgomery sit inside the Complex, Rodriguez sits by itself off of Alpine St.

## Loveland - Centennial Park,

#### From Fort Collins –

o Shields South through Loveland. Fields on the left approximately 1 mile past Hwy 34.

#### From Elsewhere –

o I-25 to Hwy 34 Exit. Exit East into Loveland and Taft Road. Turn South on Taft. Fields are approx. 1 mile down on the left side.

# <u>Windsor – Chimney Park (CP#1 Aaron Cook Field, CP#2 and CP#3), Diamond Valley (DV#1, DV#2, DV#3)</u>

Chimney Park (CP#1 Aaron Cook Field, CP#2, CP #3) 200 E. Chestnut St., Windsor CO 80550

- o From I-25 to Windsor Exit (Hwy 392). Turn (East) onto Hwy 392. Hwy 392 turns into Main Street (approx. 6 miles). Go through town, turn right (South) onto Hwy 257. Turn right (West) onto Chestnut Street, the three fields (Chimney Park #1 Aaron Cook Field, #2, and #3) are on the right.
- From Hwy 34 to Windsor Exit (Hwy 257). Turn (North) onto Hwy 257. Turn (West) onto Chestnut Street, the three fields are on the right.

#### Diamond Valley: (DV#1, DV#2, DV#3) 801 Diamond Valley Dr., Windsor CO 80550

- From I-25 to the Windsor Exit (HWY 392). Turn (East) onto Hwy 392. Hwy 392 turns into Main Street (approx. 6 miles). Go through town, turn right (South) onto Hwy 257. Turn (East) onto Garden Drive. Turn (South) onto Diamond Valley Dr. Parking lot entrance is on your left
- From Hwy 34 to Windsor Exit (Hwy 257). Turn (North) onto Hwy 257. Turn (East) onto Garden Drive. Turn (South) onto Diamond Valley Dr. Parking lot entrance is on your left

#### Windsor High School: (HS Varsity, JV, and Varsity SB) 1100 Main St., Windsor CO 80550

o From I-25 to the Windsor Exit (HWY 392). Turn (East) onto Hwy 392. Hwy 392 turns into Main Street (approx. 4 miles). Turn (North) onto 11<sup>th</sup> street. High School Parking lot is on the right.

## Wellington Library Park; Library Park South Field: 3800 Wilson Ave (80549),

- o South Field is in the south east corner of park.
- o From I-25: take Wellington exit and head west, right (north) at stoplight (6<sup>th</sup> Street), left at Wilson (approx four blocks north), field is about one block west on Wilson.
- o From Hwy 1: enter Wellington, left (north) at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street (Camacho's Mexican Restaurant is on the corner), right at Wilson (approx four blocks north), field is about one block east on Wilson.
