TRYOUT/EVALUATION PROCESS

CCYHL/Travel:

Following the USA Hockey mandated Skills and Drills sessions, prospective travel players will participate in a multi-day, multi-session tryout process to place players on teams based on ability level. Players must be registered with NCYH before arriving on the first day of tryouts. Upon arrival your player will be loaned a tryout jersey which must be worn to each tryout session. Tryouts may include both skills sessions and multiple scrimmages. After the final scrimmage is held and tryout jerseys are returned, team selection will take place and the coach will contact each family via email of their team placement. Teams are selected by the NCYH Hockey Directors .Players not selected for a travel team will be placed in the CRHL evaluations and assigned to a CRHL team.

CRHL/Rec:

One group evaluation is scheduled and teams are formed with the goal of having teams of equal competitive balance. Coaches will have a "draft" that allows them to choose a few players due to car pools and other requests made by families. The rest will be selected to ensure equality of skill level.

TOURNAMENTS

Coaches typically choose tournaments throughout the season to attend. This is at the discretion of the coach. Tournaments are generally held on holiday weekends (i.e., Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Year's, Martin Luther King, and Presidents Day weekends.) Travel will mostly be within the state, but some CCYHL teams may elect to travel out of state, maybe even out of the country (i.e., If they are successful in the Silver Stick Regional Tournament.)

CCYHL/Travel:

Tournament participation is expected from every player. If you are unable to attend a designated tournament, you are still responsible for your portion of all fees associated with that tournament regardless of attendance. NCYH requires families of travel players to pay coaches' travel expenses that may include hotel room, transportation, and a daily stipend. Coaches are asked to operate within the team's budget and save costs where available.

CRHL/Rec:

Tournaments are not mandatory to attend. However, NCYH has offered the Slapshot Tournament held in January for almost 20 years and each year our CRHL teams participate at a discounted fee. If you do not wish to participate in a tournament there is nothing to pay as cost is based per player. Teams will collect fees from participating players and submit to NCYH.

PARENT VOLUNTEER DUTIES

As a parent, you will be relied on by your team to volunteer services for a variety of team needs. Each CCYHL & CRHL team is required to have a Team Manager and each CCYHL team should also have a Team Treasurer. Additional tasks parents are expected to help with include game day duties: running the game clock, scorekeeping, and working the penalty box door. Every family must volunteer to help during your team's home games and tournaments when necessary.
