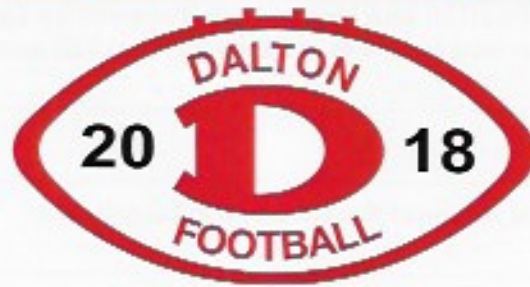


2018 Dalton Quarterback / Century Club
