This letter is being sent to the email address on the registration form; please pass this information on to the teams. Your coaches, players, and parents are responsible for the information contained in this letter!

*The event will not be cancelled or rescheduled for any reason. Teams should make every attempt to participate in the event.*

**Facility:** Doors will open at 7am, please stay in cars until then.

From Milwaukee – Take 94 West to exit North 164 & South J #294. Exit North 164 & South J and turn left (South). Proceed to the 3rd light, Northview Rd (FT). Turn right (West) on to Northview Rd. Proceed approximately ¼ mile, and the facility is on your left (South side). Park in the lot or on the street. Entrance is in the rear.

**Important Facts:**

1. Coaches must sign off on an acceptable Webpoint roster before competing in any matches on the day of the event.
  - a. Coaches on roster must have IMPACT or higher education and be safe sport certified b. Team fee paid yes or green check mark top right corner
2. Teams that have not turned in their Webpoint roster for their team will not be eligible to participate. (NO EXCEPTION!) **Please present your roster at the tournament table upon arrival to the facility.** No teams will be able to participate until the Webpoint roster has been signed by coach or other staff personnel listed on the roster. Thank you.
3. There will not be a coaches meeting, any changes will be provided to you when checking in that morning and signing the acceptable USAV roster.
4. NO food may be brought into the facility. Any coolers must be kept in the car.
5. Concessions will be provided by the facility.
6. NO gum, food, or beverages (other than water) will be allowed in the gym.
7. Gym bags should be placed on the bleachers or off to the side walls. (DO NOT STORE AT BENCHES!) . Neither Center Court nor RVA are responsible for lost or stolen items.
9. Region up referees have been requested and will be provided for all matches, based on availability within the Region.
10. Please start the warm-up time immediately following the conclusion of the previous match. This is extremely important, so that we may stay on schedule, get all the matches in, and all leave at a reasonable hour!! Please work together.
11. Teams should provide a down official (R2), scorekeeper, libero tracker, and 2 lines judges for pool play and bracket play.
12. Admission will be \$10.00 per person at the door in the form of cash only

13. RVA and Center Court first aid consist of Band-Aids and other basics. There will not be any trainers or ice available.
14. AAU Membership Numbers are required for all athletes, coaches, and any participants

**Rules:** USA Volleyball rules will be utilized. There will be a tournament directors table set up in the facility. *We ask that teams that have officiating duties bring the completed score sheets to that table before the start of warm-ups for the next match.*

**Warm-Ups:** Team warm-ups will consist of 2-4-4 prior to their first match of play (2 shared ball handling, then 4 of each team having their court time which includes serving). All subsequent matches will consist of 3-3 (each team will have to serve within the 3 minutes). The team NOT warming up, WILL stand behind the end line and assist the opponent with shagging balls with good sportsmanship. The first match of the day will start on time. All matches that follow may run ahead or behind schedule. It is the responsibility of each team to follow the progress on their next assigned court and be ready to play when the court is available.

**Format:** Matches will consist of best of 3, unless otherwise noted on schedules. The first two games rally scored to 25 points and the third, if necessary, rally score to 15 points. All games are won by 2, no cap. The event is scheduled to conclude by or near 5:00 pm. If the pool of teams in any division is large, or many playoff games are necessary, the early rounds of playoffs may consist of a single game to 15 or 25. The site director will determine whether playoff rounds will be condensed based on the time playoffs will start and considering how many rounds of playoff will be required.

**Tie Breakers:** There will not be any tie breakers. Rather, crossover seed/position assignments shall be determined by the following. If 2 teams are tied, the higher seed will go to the winner of head to head. If 3 teams are tied, all three teams will be ranked by the following criteria in order: GAME WINNING % (games won divided by games played), then TOTAL POINT DIFFERENTIAL (total # of points won subtracted from total # of points lost), the COIN FLIP.

This process should allow all the teams to have a minimum of 4 matches, and end the day at a reasonable hour. Any Questions, please ask the site directors.
