

2021 NEA JBB Jr High League

- Tentative schedule: Games will begin on March 1st and the Postseason Tournament will be the week of May 10th.
- Regular and Postseason Tournament Awards
- Games on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday nights with Wednesday nights as makeups for rainouts.
- Time Limits will be 1 hour 45 minutes for 7 inning games and 1 hour and 30 minutes for 5 inning games. DH will be a 7 inning game 1 and 5 inning game 2.
- All 8th grade teams must register as a 14u ALL STAR TEAM team and 7th Grade teams as a 13u ALL STAR team on the USSSA website as their School name. You must purchase team insurance. To roster a player it will require you to have the player's legal name, date of birth, and parent/guardian information. Every coach must sign the official USSSA Roster when the season starts. If there are any additions to your roster after the season starts they must be added on the USSSA website before they play. A new signed roster will be required when the player is added. All player MUST attend the School they play for in this league.
- Players are eligible to play league and regular weekend travel ball.
- Pitchers are limited to 2 innings per night.
- Due to playing on school nights we will use the 5 runs per inning rule. Game mercy rules will be the same as USSSA: 15 after 3/12 after 4/8 after 5 or whenever a team is mathematically eliminated.
- Each team can hit a standard 9 or 10 (with EH) or a continuous lineup. However, you must hit the same way the whole game. If you are hitting a continuous lineup and have an injury you must take an out in the vacated spot in the lineup. If you fall below 8 players in a game it is a forfeit.
- Entry Fee is \$400 per team. JBB will provide baseballs. Gate fee is \$5 per night for everyone over 5yo.

- Home team is the official book and visitors keep the scoreboard (wireless controllers).
- Bat rules are covered at www.arkansasusssa.com under the Rules tab and are as follows: 8th grade follows 14u and 7th grade follows 13u bat rules (14u max drop of -5 and 13u max drop of -8)
