

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The SnVYSA Board aspires to help all youth soccer players develop physically, mentally, and emotionally over time while participating in SnVYSA organized and supervised programs.

This **Parent Code of Conduct** applies to all parents and guardians of player(s) participating in SnVYSA's Recreational and Cascade FC programs and any other SnVYSA organized and supervised activity or event.

The SnVYSA Board has adopted this Parent Code of Conduct and expects all parents to agree and comply with it. Violation of this Parent Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action up to and including that which is outlined below.

I AFFIRM I WILL:
Participation
Support my player(s) in their commitment to play and participate in youth soccer in a positive and constructive manner. This includes cheering for all players and offering encouragement.
Read, review, and discuss the Player Code of Conduct with my player and support them in complying with the Code.
Ensure my child attends all practices and games and arrives on time and is properly equipped to play. If your child is unable to attend, you will inform the coach through the Sports Engine app, by text, and/or by email, as soon as you know they are unable to attend.
Sportsmanship
Be a positive role model by demonstrating behavior that is respectful, courteous, and supportive of the referees, coaches, players, opponents, and spectators while in attendance at practices, games, or any team event.
Promote a positive and safe environment for all players and prioritize the well-being of players over the desire to win.
Refrain from coaching or directing players from the sidelines during practices or games.
Respect
Treat all coaches, players, staff members, opponents, spectators, and referees with respect on and off the field always.
Value and trust the opinions of my player(s) coach(es) without inappropriately interfering with decisions or operations.
Respect and follow the rules of the fields and facilities and keep them clean and in good condition.
Behavior
Appreciate diversity and ensure that everyone is treated with fairness and respect.
Promote a safe space for all players where any form of abuse and harassment, whether verbal, physical, emotional, or sexual is not tolerated.
Communications
Address any concerns or questions about coaching by arranging a discussion with the coach at a mutually agreed-upon time after the game. A 48-hour cool-off period will be observed by all parties involved before any conversations take place.
Reporting
Report any safety concerns in good faith to my players coach, SnVYSA Directors, Cascade FC Directors, and/or the U.S. Center for SafeSport when I believe any individual engaged in any SnVYSA organized and supervised event has violated the Codes of Conduct, Prohibited Conduct, or other SnVYSA Safety and Prohibited Conduct policies.
Understand and act upon the SafeSport mandatory reporting obligations and report any suspected child abuse to law enforcement and to the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
Understand the Coach Code of Conduct and report safety concerns to SnVYSA Directors or Cascade FC Directors when I have reason to believe, in good faith, a violation has occurred.

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Report any safety concerns with equipment or facilities to my players coach, a Cascade FC Director, or the SnVYSA Facilities and Equipment managers.

I AFFIRM I WILL NOT:

Behavior

Verbally, physically, sexually, or emotionally abuse, harass, or haze any player, coach, team staff, referee, opponent, or spectator.

Use derogatory, discriminatory, or profane language while in attendance at any practice, game, or team event.

Confront a coach or staff member during, or immediately after, any practice, game, or event.

Illegal Substances

Illegally use or possess drugs, alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, or vape while participating in a SnVYSA organized and supervised practice, game, team event, camp, clinic, or any other field event.

Discipline For Violations

If the parent or guardian violates this **Parent Code of Conduct**, the parent or guardian **MAY** face disciplinary action by the Team Coach, Cascade FC Directors, and/or the SnVYSA Disciplinary Committee based on the severity of the offense from a verbal warning up to including removal from the team and/or association.

All Parent Code of Conduct violations are required to be documented. Any violation that may result in the parent or guardian being suspended or removed will be escalated to the SnVYSA Disciplinary Committee for review and decision before a parent or guardian is suspended or removed.
