Boys Basketball Wins Regional Championship!

The Boys Varsity Basketball team beat Niles West 65-42 on Friday to win their first 4A regional championship in 10 years!

"We were just really blessed that we got to win this game," Dominic Martinelli told the Glenview Lantern. "We're really happy."

From the Lantern:

Parents joined the Titans' student fan section in swarming the court after the final buzzer, on Friday, March 1, in Hoffman Estates. A regional plaque was held high, much hooting and hugging ensued, and one-by-one players climbed a ladder so each could have a hand in cutting down the net.

Martinelli stood with his small piece of that net hanging from his right ear as he talked about the win.

"We've already played (Niles West) twice and it's hard to beat a team three times. They're a tough team," he said. "We're a second-half team and we've been working all year on our conditioning and our mental toughness. I feel like today we brought that, in our biggest game so far this year."

The box score shows that Martinelli's 26 points led the way offensively and the Titans' leading scorer was in fine form against Niles West, whether he was driving to the basket, getting his shot off in the lane, or getting open for easy points.

But it was Mac Hubbard who got the ball rolling early in the contest. The senior guard sank three three-pointers in the first half that energized the Titans on their way to a 32-15 halftime lead.

"I really thought those threes early really set the tone," Titans coach Phil Ralston said. "It kind of made our kids feel like they were in control of the game, and in control of their own destiny tonight."

Hubbard competed in the IHSA's annual three-point shooting contest prior to the game, qualifying for the next round along with teammate Jimmy McMahan. Hubbard hit two threes in the first quarter and his third three gave the Titans an 18-9 lead in the second.

"When you're feeling it, you're feeling it, and it definitely brings a whole other energy to the team," Hubbard said. "I knocked down some shots and then the whole team felt good."

When the Titans feel good, Will King (12 points) is usually in the thick of things. The senior floor general directed the offense throughout, slowing things down, taking the ball to the basket, or finding teammates for open looks.

"He's the best point guard I've ever played with," Martinelli said of King. "He's insane."

Hubbard finished with nine points and McMahan scored seven in the win. Niles West cut its deficit to 12 points in the fourth quarter but never got any closer to Glenbrook South (25-8) as Martinelli scored 13 of his 26 points in the fourth quarter.

"We kind of opened the door a little bit but these kids are so resilient," Ralston said. "They didn't let a couple mistakes phase them. They've

played together for a long time and I think now you're seeing the maturation process with these guys."

On Wednesday, the Titans beat Conant 47-43 in a regional semifinal, in Hoffman Estates.

The Titans face Evanston in a sectional semifinal at Niles North on Tuesday, at 7 p.m. in Skokie. Let's pack the gym!

Alumni Update, Girls Basketball: Lizzy Shaw & Ashley Oldshue

Two former Glenbrook South basketball helped their schools reach the Division 3 NCAA Basketball Tournament. **Lizzy Shaw**, a freshman at the University of Chicago, and **Ashley Oldshue**, a senior at Emory University, were instrumental in their team's selection to the tournament.

Both teams were 19-6 during the regular season, and faced tough first-round matchups. Chicago lost to Oglethorpe, who entered the game with a 23-6 record, 57-51. Emory faced the #5 ranked team in the country, Trine University, who sported a 25-2 record entering the contest. Emory led throughout much of the game, but lost a heartbreaker 57-54. Oldshue concluded her phenomenal career with 24 points and 12 rebounds, almost single-handedly leading her team to victory. Oldshue was selected first-team UAA for the third consecutive year, only the second player in Emory history to achieve the award three straight years.

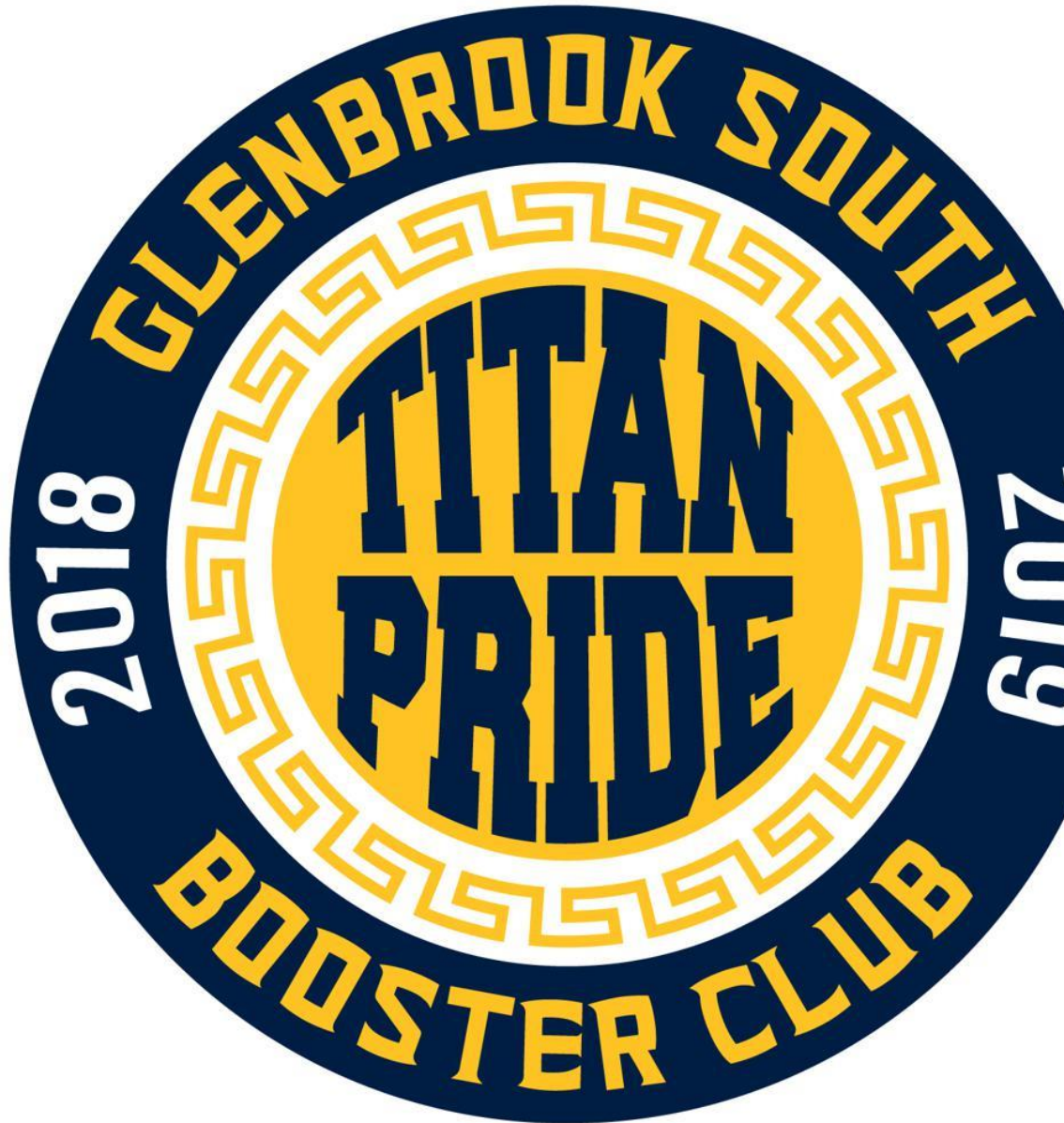
Step 2: Parents sign in to your Parent Portal on PowerSchool. Go to Sports Survey, choose the sport your student would like to try out for and click submit.
