- Boys camp discussion at meeting. Camps will be mid-September in the Auxiliary Gym and occur for three consecutive weeks.

Coaches Update to WMYBA Goals

When we met a year ago, the goal for WMYBA were:

- Varsity coaching staff would like to see the WMYBA keep youth play light.
 Coaches want to see the kids have fun & move into the high school playing
 years with that attitude, we want to eliminate burnout from being pushed. This
 approach would hopefully keep more kids around to play the game as they get
 older.
- Principles at a youth level into high school play
- As players exit WMYBA and move in to 9th Grade/high school level, coaches expectations are for players to know all positions and be versatile in these spots. Understand ball screens, how to post up, play defense, and understand ball pressure, with an understanding of man defense.
- Both varsity coaches agree to maintain current principles.

Donation Request

• Donation request made by Head Varsity Boys Basketball Coach, Kent Janikula, to provide donation for new uniforms. Typically, uniforms last 3 to 4 seasons and this upcoming season will be season 4. The request would be for the 2020-2021 season. Is this something we've donated to in the past and

would this come from the coaches account? Boys varsity is looking for about \$2,500.00 to the 2020-2021 season for new uniforms.

Tournament Dates

Uniforms and Equipment

- Incoming 4th Graders will have to purchase uniforms for this season, uniforms will be reversible jersey, and shorts. Andy J. will set up a time for a meeting regarding apparel.
- The board needs to vote if we wish to contribute \$20 to the cost of the uniforms as we did when we started the new uniform policy. Board unanimously votes yes, this will continue. Players will be able to try on uniforms for sizing at Country Side Apparel in Waconia. If you need an additional uniform, you will pay the full price.
- WYMBA also will need to acquire blood jerseys for the upcoming 4th grade teams and consider the uniform numbers not to match the incoming 5th graders numbers. Board agrees.

Coaches Meeting

- I have attached a 'Coaches Checklist' sheet. Each coach has to check the boxes and sign the sheet to make sure they complete the background check, concussion training, read sexual abuse policy, etc. This is a compliance document. Thoughts? Board agrees.

Third Grade

- As voted on last year, each 3rd grade team can sign up for 2 Waconia league Saturdays. The registration fee of \$80 will cover the extra practice and league play. Board agrees.
- We will go over details during the coaches meeting for 3rd grade coaches. Board agrees.
- Allow more practice time for 3rd grade and make weeknights available as well. Discuss with 3rd grade coaches regarding more weeknight and Saturday practices.

• We need a different option for a 'jersey' for 3rd. Last year officials had a hard time distinguishing numbers because they were only on the back. Andy thoughts? Board agrees that re-design of jersey is necessary to have number on the front and back of jersey.
