



Baseball 6U Rules

General Rules

1. Games will have a 50 minute time limit.
2. If 50 minutes hits mid-inning, that inning must be finished.
3. No official score is kept.
4. Home/Away teams will be decided by the coaches before each game.
5. Home team will always have the last at-bats.
6. All players present on a team will play in the field and bat each inning.

Fielding

7. Defensive players must change positions each inning.
8. Defensive teams must have 5 infielders with the remainder of the players in the outfield grass (or a reasonable distance behind infielders).
9. All players must play in the infield at least one inning per game.
10. Coaches are encouraged to rotate players between the infield and outfield positions equally.
11. Coaches may stand in the field to help direct players during play.

Batting

- 12. Each batter will receive 5 pitches per at bat. If they do not get a hit, the ball will be placed on a tee for them to hit.**
13. All batters will wear a protective helmet.
14. Teams will bat a continuous lineup where all players in the lineup bat and then switch sides.
15. The last batter will clear the bases and the teams will switch sides upon the last batter touching home plate. Preferably a different batter will clear the bases each inning.

Baserunning

16. Outs will not count. Runners will continue to run the bases.
17. Runners advance 1 base at a time.
18. Hitters may run to 2nd base on a hit into the outfield grass.
19. Runners on base during a hit to the outfield can advance 2 bases as well.
20. Runners may advance 1 base on an overthrow at first base. Runners may not advance on an overthrow at any other base.
