Accomplishments:

1. A document outlining the expectations and duties of UWH Committee members and appointed directors. The document adds to those already established in the bylaws adding wording about
2. Three teams and three referees represented the USA at Age Group Worlds in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The U19 Men took eighth place, U24 Women took eighth, and U24 Men took ninth. Juan Diego achieved a 2 star rating for his reffing, and Rosa achieved a 3 star rating for her reffing.
3. All of the regional director positions have been filled for the first time in a while and directors have been pretty active in their respective regions working to help build and support UWH regionally.
4. We had enough people interested in joining the UWH committee that we had to hold an election for positions this year.
5. First trial of making Nationals a club only event went moderately well. Regional directors were put in charge of approving rosters. Plan for the upcoming year is to improve communication surrounding the event and continue to consider how to improve this process.

Important things in progress:

1. Tournament Regulations Handbook – this was put on the back burner for this year, but resources for hosting tournaments have been started and will eventually be compiled so that any member can use it as a reference and guide.

2. Work to clarify the wording surrounding what constitutes a club team/club team member, working within the bounds of the SCR/UWH bylaws and feasibility of what is actually enforceable. The context is to make it more straightforward for club-focused events.

3. 2025 World's Qualifiers was changed by the CMAS BOD such that the Americas will not be competing with Asia/Oceania in Kuala Lumpur. New plan will be an Americas event, location and date are TBD.
