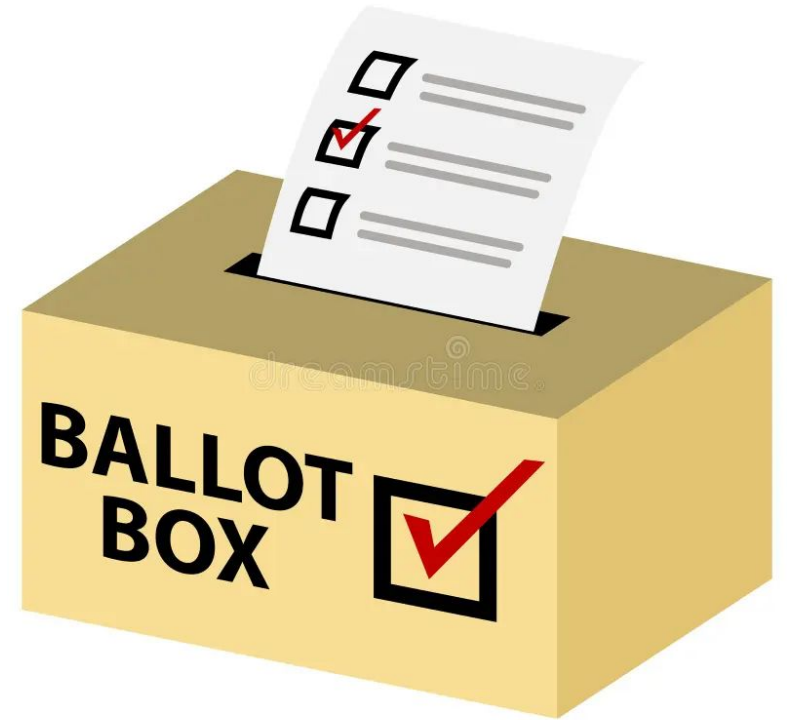

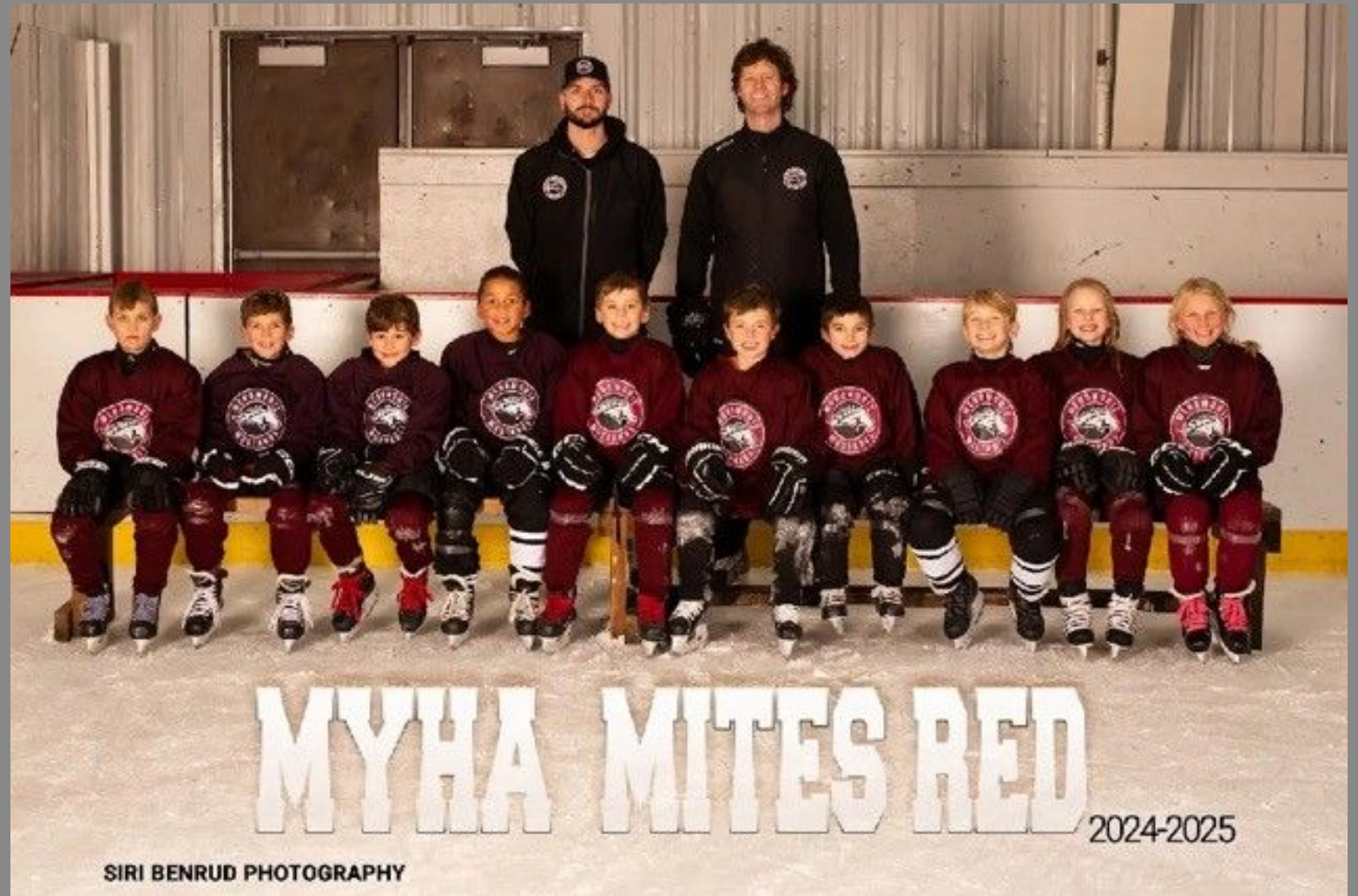

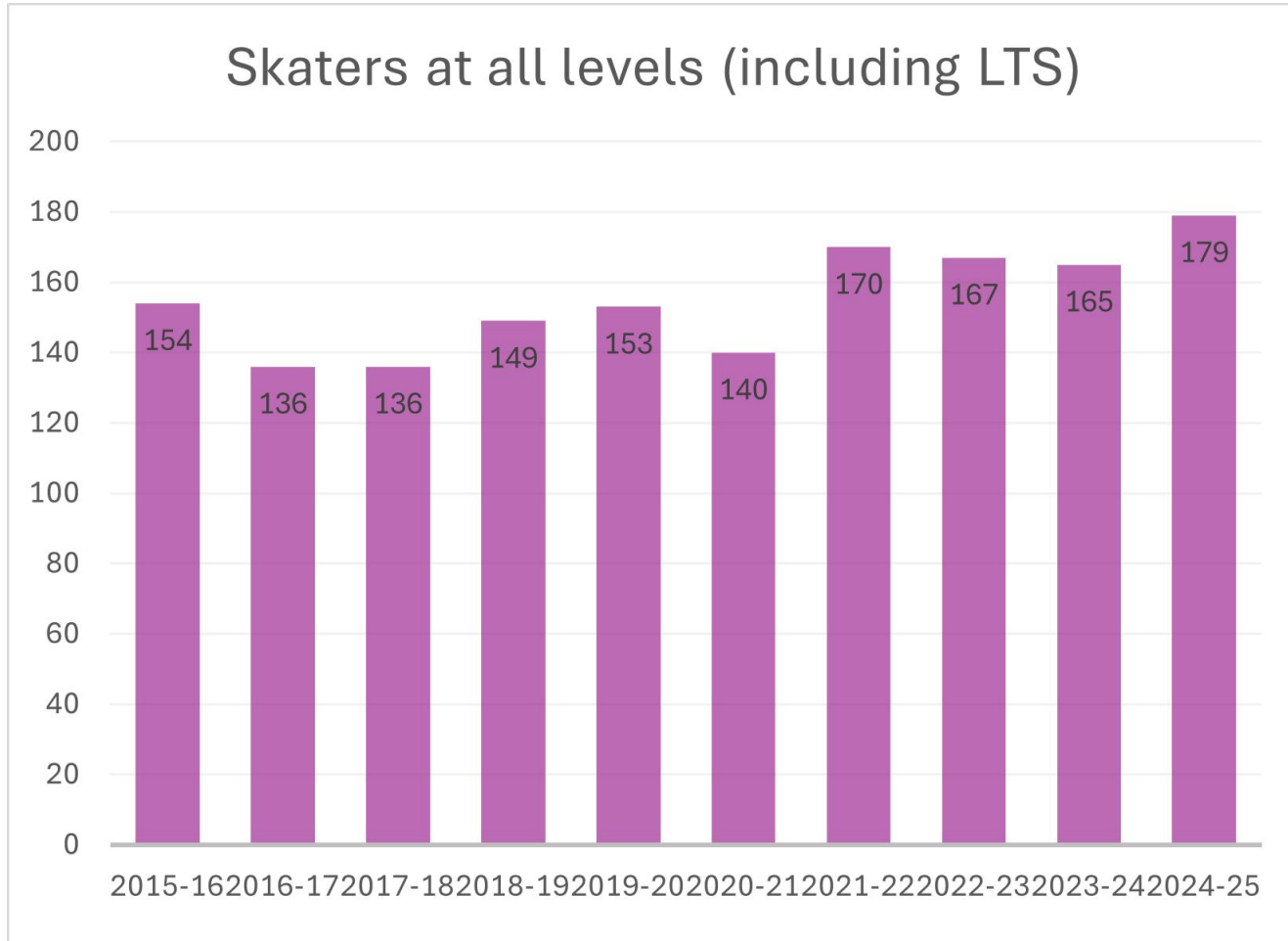

Financial summary/highlights

- Ice time continues to be a good deal, we used the ice \$105k worth but were charged \$100k
- Lost a number of skaters and big donations this year, so revenues decreased across the board; necessary to go lean
 - \$60k less revenue from last year but expenses down about the same
 - Concessions margin increased considerably; “shopped” more for inputs, received donated goods/services
 - Not hosting state and revised playdowns scheduling model was a big revenue loss, but tournament scheduling and expenses were more consistent and targeted this year
 - Mite Jamboree a huge success (\$13,250 revenue, up from \$10,800 last year)!
- Wreath profit margin improved again, moving from 36.4% to 41.4%; KT car wash cards margin roughly the same (50%)
 - Over 15 families still owe for wreaths/KT card, will be receiving invoices
 - Wreath/KT card buyout structure likely to change next year
 - Opportunities for growth: corporate sponsorships, sign program, extra/voluntary fundraisers (such as MN Wild Tix)

Membership Growth/Registration Trends:



- **The future is bright! Huge increase in LTS program!**
- **Loss of older skaters to VSA, ECYH, MHS**
- **Increase in girls participating and joining MYHA. Girls hockey continues to grow nation-wide.**
- **Huge increase in girls participating in the Co-Op U10-14 vs. MYHA**

Utilization & Maximization of WAP Hours



- Concessions and Open Skate did not have to be closed this year due to lack of staffing. Thank you!
 - However, multiple families put in *MANY* hours above and beyond while others have unmet requirements.
 - Invoices for unmet DIBS requirements will be sent in coming weeks.

Opportunity: WE STILL NEED MORE MEMBER HELP!!

- **DIB requirements and concession hours were increased, which may have helped with concessions staffing, but many committee openings remained.**
- **As a 100% VOLUNTEER ORGANIZATION we continue to need to find a way to share the load. Everyone needs to pitch in.**

Equipment & Facility Improvements

- Repaired black cross-ice barriers/pads.
- Won back-to-back WAHA grant **for** new equipment (10 sets per yr)
- Removed all old gear (Play-it-Again credit). Thanks for donations.
- 4 Medium-sized (mite) nets and 6 new small (LTS) nets.
- Sparx Skate Sharpener has new secure storage cabinet (thank you John)**
- New practice jerseys for all Squirt, Peewee and Bantams. **HURLBURTS!!**
 - New Equipment Room planned! Pending permits.
 - Expanded fan gear. Vintage jerseys being sold.
- Lost and Found. Return practice jerseys and LTS equipment.
- What to expect for next season:**
 - WAHA Grant**
 - Update Skates for Sunday open skate.**
 - Formal DIBS process for skate sharpening.**
 - Complete Equipment Room**
