U5 & U6

General Info

Field: U5 primary HW5-C, U6 Boys HW5-A, U6 Girls HW5-B (U5 will use 5-A & 5-B at 9am) 4 v 4, no goalkeeper

No goalkeeping. Players can play defensively but not stand immediately in front of the net

4 x 8 minute periods, water break after period 1 and 3, 5 minute halftime

No paid referees, both coaches or a parent from each team act as "referees"

No keeping score

Both coaches should confer prior to the game to "get on the same page" Coaches allowed on field to direct play but stand clear as much as possible Strict officiating not required but teach the game and rules as best you can Free substitution after any dead ball

Set Up (first game only, each field)

Each team sets up one goal. Unfold and click into place. No corner flags in U5/U6.

Tear Down (last game only, each field)

Each team puts away one goal.

Goals only need to be folded in half. DO NOT USE EXCESSIVE FORCE TO FOLD

Stored in the Heartwell shed at northwest corner of Field 1

Field Lining

No line painting should be required. Fields are pre-lined by Fields crew. If not lined, find a volunteer to help. Ensure they know how to operate the painters. Report unlined fields to Jim Marshall.

U6-SPECIFIC RULES

In general, IFAB/FIFA Laws of the Game apply but very loosely at this age. Both coaches should confer before the game so they are on the same page and both teams are held to the same standards/rules.

Throw-ins - Work with players to make legal throw-ins. Give them a second (or third) try to get it right. Then switch throw-in to other team. Kick-ins are optional.

Goal Kicks – For U5/6, all kicks over the goal line are *always* a goal kick. Honor system, but don't encourage defending kids to kick it out intentionally to gain possession.

Out of Bounds - Ball out of play calls do not have to be strict "to the inch" but limit how far and how often you allow the ball to go out of bounds during a game. It's part of the learning process but you also want the game to flow and limit interruptions.

Build Out Line (mid-field line for U5/6) - There is no separate 'Build Out Line' on the field. Prior to goal kicks, the defending team retreats **behind the midfield line**. Defending team does not attack until the ball is kicked into play.

NEW! 6 v 6, 5 plus 1 goalkeeper

2 x 20 minute halves, 5 minute half, water break at/near the 10th minute at referee's discretion

One paid referee. Do NOT pay referees. We are invoiced for U8 refs.

Coaches remain off the field and on their own touchline.

Free substitution after any dead ball

PREPARE A GAME CARD FOR THE REFEREE: LBYSO Game Card (print at lbyso.org/coachescorner)

Set Up (first game only, each field)

Each team sets up one 10x5 goal and two corner flags.

Tear Down (last game only, each field)

Each team puts away one goal and net and two flags. Goals disassemble as two triangles, two corner braces, crossbar

Goals and flags

Stored in the Heartwell shed at northwest corner of Field 1

Field Lining

No line painting should be required. Fields are pre-lined by Fields crew. If not lined, find a volunteer to help. Ensure they know how to operate the painters. Report unlined fields to Jim Marshall.

U8-SPECIFIC RULES

In general, IFAB/FIFA Laws of the Game apply. Modifications provide for transition from U6 and to U10.

Confer with the referee and other coach to confirm the game will be called as described here.

Throw-ins – All balls that go over the touch line will be a throw in. At the referee's discretion, players may be allowed a second try. Then switch throw-in to other team.

Goal Kicks/Corner Kicks – **NEW!** Standard rules apply. Goal kicks do NOT have to leave the "12 yard box" before a teammate can play the ball.

Build Out Line - There is a blue 'Build Out Line'. On goal kicks <u>OR</u> goalkeeper possession, defending team retreats to the Build Out Line. Defending team does not attack until the ball is put in play.

- When the goalkeeper has the ball in their hands during play from the opponent (or before a goal kick), the opposing team moves behind the build out line until the ball is in play.
- The goalkeeper can kick, throw or roll the ball into play (punts/drop kicks are not allowed in U8)
- After the ball is put into play, the opposing team can attack
- The goalkeeper can put the ball into play immediately upon possession but does so accepting the positioning of the opponents.

Free substitution after any dead ball

Set up

Home team retrieves 4 flags and one U10 duffel bag (goal nets, spikes, hammer) from the storage box located between the community center and basketball court

Each team sets up one goal and 2 flags

Tear Down (last game only, each field)

Remove nets. Each team puts away one goal. Two goals stacked and locked to the fence together Home teams takes flags and nets to storage.

Goals

18 foot goals locked to NORTH side fence at the hard courts near the community center. Unlock the wheels and roll goals (PULL the goals by the posts). Attach nets.

Field Lining

No line painting should be required. Fields should be pre-lined Fridays by Fields crew. If it was not done, please find a volunteer. Ensure they know how to operate the painters.

U10-SPECIFIC RULES

In general, IFAB/FIFA Laws of the Game apply.

Goal kicks do NOT have to leave the "12 yard box" before a teammate can play the ball.

Build Out Line - There is a blue 'Build Out Line'. For goal kicks <u>OR</u> goalkeeper possession, defending team retreats behind the Build Out Line. Defending team does not attack until the ball is put in play.

- When the goalkeeper has the ball in their hands during play from the opponent (or before a goal kick), the opposing team moves behind the build out line until the ball is in play.
- The goalkeeper can kick, throw or roll the ball into play (punts/drop kicks are not allowed)
- After the ball is put into play by the goalkeeper, the opposing team can attack and play resumes as normal ("put into play" = kicked, thrown or rolled)
- The goalkeeper can put the ball into play immediately upon possession but does so accepting the positioning of the opponents.




