Departure from USA

Departure from USA to Barcelona, Spain. Snacks and overnight on the plane.

Day 2 – 19th July 2023
Barcelona arrival / Montserrat / Training #1

Arrival in Barcelona Int. Airport and meeting with your bilingual tour manager and your private motor coach.

Transfer to Montserrat and free time to stroll around and recover from the long travel.

Day 3 – 20th July 2023
RCD Espanyol Pro Training #2 /
Barcelona guided visit / Match #1

After breakfast, transfer to the RCD Espanyol sport centre. Pro training session with their qualified coaches.



Transfer to Barcelona city centre and lunch on your own. Then enjoy a guided tour of Barcelona downtown: Las Ramblas, La Bouqueria and all the beautiful corners of the city.



Barcelona is the capital and the most populous city of the Autonomous Community of Catalonia and the second largest city in Spain, after Madrid. Barcelona is recognised as a Global City due to its importance in finance, commerce, media, entertainment, arts, international trade, education and tourism. Indeed, it is a major economic centre and a growing financial centre. Barcelona occupies 13th place in the world on Innovation Cities globally. It is the 4th richest city by GDP in the European Union. Enjoy botanical and urban parks, sandy beaches, the metropolitan area, art Museums as those of Picasso and Mirò together with the Maritime, the Archeology and Science one.

Later in the afternoon you will play your first friendly match vs local teams.

Day 4 – 21st July 2023 Camp Nou Stadium Tour / Barceloneta beach

After breakfast, we head to the amazing Camp Nou, home of FC Barcelona for a guided visit.



Camp Nou - built between 1954 and 1957, officially opened on the 24th of September 1957. Camp Nou initially consisted of two tiers that could hold 93,000 spectators. It was first called Estadi del FC Barcelona, but got soon referred to as Camp Nou. He then expanded with a third tier for the 1982 World Cup, which raised capacity to 120,000 places. Now the capacity is around 100,000 seats, due to some other changes. In the mid 2000s, the club presented plans for a renovated Camp Nou, designed by Norman Foster, but a lack of funding prevented realization. These some of the most important

games of past: In 1989, Camp Nou hosted the European Cup final between AC Milan and FC Steaua (4-0), in 1999 by the Champions League final between Manchester United and FC Bayern (2-1).

Tour of the stadium & Museum, possibility to enjoy the official shopping centre.

Transfer to Barcelona beach area "Barceloneta".



Free time to spend at the Barceloneta beach, the most famous of all Catalonia region and time to walk and enjoy the well known "Las Ramblas" and lunch on you own.



Transfer back to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 – 22nd July 2023 Transfer Valencia / Wine-Food Tasting (Optional) / Free time

After breakfast transfer to Valencia.

Stops on the way for a wine tasting / lunch in a Old farm (Optional).



Arrival in Valencia and free time in the city centre – beach area.



Check-in at your hotel, dinner and overnight.



Day 6 – 23rd July 2023
Training session #3 / Valencia / Oceanographic e Ciudad de las Artes (Optional) / Free time at the Beach / Match #2

Breakfast at your hotel then transfer to a local sports centre for a training session with your own coaches.



Lunch on your own and later time to visit the beautiful Oceanographic and the Hemisferic.



Free time at the beach to relax and enjoy the Mediterranean sea.

In the late afternoon transfer to a local sports centre to play a friendly game vs. a local opponent.



Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 7 – 24th July 2023
Transfer Madrid / Santiago Bernabeu stadium tour

After breakfast transfer to Madrid.

Arrival in Madrid and lunch on your own.

Free time and in the afternoon transfer to Santiago Bernabeu Stadium for a visit of the glorious stadium. Don't forget to take pictures!



Santiago Bernabeu - The stadium opened in 1947 under the name Nuevo Estadio Chamartín. Its current name is in honour of the man

who was president of the club for 35 years, Santiago Bernabéu. After various remodelling projects, it is today classified as an elite stadium, and holds the UEFA's highest distinction of five stars. This is the second largest football stadium in Spain, with a capacity of around 80,000 spectators. The visit to the stadium includes access to Real Madrid's well-stocked trophy room, the presidential box and a chance to walk around the technical area and see the dressing rooms of the visiting team. The stadium also has various restaurants, a large club shop and a shopping area.

Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Madrid area.

Day 8 – 25th July 2023 Full day Toledo

After breakfast transfer to Toledo, one of the most historical city of entire Spain.

Toledo is considered most representative of Spanish culture, and its historic centre was designated a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1986.



Toledo: successively a Roman municipium, the capital of the Visigothic Kingdom, a fortress of the Emirate of Cordoba, an outpost of the Christian kingdoms fighting the Moors and, in the 16th century, the temporary seat of supreme power under Charles V, Toledo is the repository of more than 2,000 years of history. Its masterpieces are the product of heterogeneous civilizations in an environment where the existence of three major religions – Judaism, Christianity and Islam – was a major factor.

Your guide will highlight some of Toledo's famous attractions.

You can spend the first part of the day visiting the city's two most important monuments: the Cathedral and the Alcázar fortress. You'll be amazed by them.

Then free time and lunch on your own in the city centre.

In the afternoon, we'll head to the Castile-La Mancha library and outdoor terraces to enjoy coffee, snacks and

head up one of the towers to enjoy the panoramic aerial views of Toledo.

Later transfer back to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9 – 26th July 2023 Atletico de Madrid Pro Training #4 / Madrid guided visit / Match #3 / Dinner in the city centre

After breakfast transfer to Atletico de Madrid training centre for a session with Atletico de Madrid coaches. Take note of their precious advices!



Lunch on your own and in the afternoon meeting with your bilingual guide who will explain you all the beauties of the Spanish Capital.

Take picture of Puerta del Sol, la Gran Via, Plaza del Cibeles, Plaza Mayor and many others.



Madrid is the capital and largest city of Spain. The city is located on the river Manzanares in the centre of both the country and the Community of Madrid. It has preserved the look and feel of many of its historic neighbourhoods and streets. Its landmarks include the huge Royal Palace of Madrid; the Royal theatre with its restored 1850 Opera House; the Buen Retiro park, the imposing 19th-century National Library building containing some of Spain's historical archives; an archaeological museum; and three superb art museums: Prado Museum, which hosts one of the finest art collections in the world, Museo Nacional Centro de Arte Reina Sofía, a museum of modern art, and the Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum, housed in the renovated Villahermosa Palace.

Later transfer in a local sports centre you will play a friendly match with local teams.



Dinner in and overnight at your hotel.
