* Skaters that enter an Adult "C" event may challenge only to Adult "B" age-appropriate event.

* Skaters in any Adult "B" division may "challenge-up" to an age-appropriate "A" division and skate both divisions

* Skaters in any Adult "A" division may "challenge-up" to a Premier division and skate both divisions.

* Skaters who "challenge-up" and do not place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the "challenged-up" division at the American Championships have the option to return to their age-appropriate division for the following season, unless they have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in their age-appropriate division at the American Championships (see move up rules).

JUDGING CRITERIA FOR SMALL CIRCLES

* Remember this year we have posted the judging criteria for the body motions required to receive a full score for the execution and placement of small circles.

1. Accurate execution of strike offs, take offs either pivot or pocket equally credited.
2. Accurate execution of transitions from a controlled edge to edge smoothly.

3. Appropriate free leg movement to mimic the rotation of the body and change of position of the free leg prior to the transition. Another pass of free leg prior to the entry shoulder to a trailing position and passes forward at the long axis of the inset to achieve a forward position at the exit shoulder as it would when the loop is executed. The arms may be positioned to achieve the correct rotation and balance as required by the coach/skater.

* The small circles should be a stepping stone into the execution of a loop, as such, there is a rhythm to the body and rotation that is not accomplished with the basic balance position.

* There will be a mandatory deduction if the body rotation and free leg movements are not executed (suggestion to Judges panel, 10 point deduction if the body is held in a basic static position; i.e., "balance" position).

I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any skater, coach, official/judge, vendor, or any other attendee.

I will not initiate a disturbance or fight with any skater, coach, official/judge, vendor, or any other attendee.

I hereby agree that if I fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, officiating/judging, or participating in an American Roller Sports competition I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

- (a) Verbal warning.
- (b) Written warning.
- (c) Suspension or immediate ejection from an ARS competition issued by the Competition Manager.
- (d) Suspension from multiple ARS competition issued by the IHA Board or their designee.
- (e) Season suspension or multiple season suspension issued by the IHA Board or their designee.
