 - O As of Aug 20th; MYHA has \$300k cash in the bank
 - Most players take advantage of the payment schedule so we will not receive 100% of the season tuition upfront.
 - All the boys tournaments are paid for and a portion of the girls tournaments; at this point- girls tournaments are scheduled by RYHA.
 - o Total tournament expenses have been \$89k.
 - Once registration is finalized, we will have a good view of our income for the season and if we have any adjustments we need to make in spending.
 - Will confirm with our accountants if we will be subject to an audit for the 2022-2023 season; audit is based on our final revenue for the year; threshold is \$750k.
