## TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

1. Games will be held on Kosinski fields.
2. Rings are awarded to the top Three teams, with sweatshirts awarded to the champions.
3. Double-elimination tournament.
4. All balls furnished by the tournament director.
5. No pick ups from eliminated teams will be allowed without approval from the tournament director/s. Teams with 9 or more players will not be allowed to pick up players. If a pick up is allowed the team picking up will only be allowed to play a max of 9 players.
6. Game time is forfeit time. There will be no grace period unless a team is involved in a previous game. All games will have a $45-$ minute time limit.
7. Home team will be determined by a coin toss prior to the start of the game.
8. Snowshoes will be provided by Greater Anchorage, Inc. All players MUST wear the provided shoes and bindings. Tape, rubber, strapping and bungee cord, etc., may be used to help keep snowshoes on.
9. Managers and players are responsible for returning snowshoes to the storage area after each game.
10. Any violation of the rules may result in forfeiture and ejection from the tournament for the player and/or the teams involved. The spirit of this tournament is to enjoy yourself, play good softball, and add to the Alaskan spirit of Rondy. Unsportsmanlike conduct such as vulgar language, intoxication, any physical violence, or offer of violence or purposeful physical contact
will NOT be tolerated. Violation of these rules will result in disqualification and potential suspension from future ASA events.
11. All batters will begin with a one ball, two strike count. A foul ball is considered an out.
12. For safety purposes no Sliding or Diving. If a player slides or dives it will result in an out.
13. An inning ends after 3 outs or when a team has batted through their lineup.
14. After 30 minutes, an 8 -run rule is in effect.
15. Teams must have a minimum of nine (9) players to play each game. An out will be counted for each missing player in the lineup.
16. To achieve full participation, teams may bat all players in attendance.
MANAGER GUIDELINES
17. Each manager is responsible for his or her team member's conduct.
18. Each manager is responsible for making sure all of his/her players have signed the waiver of liability form. Any team found with a player or players in a game without a signed waiver will be disqualified and ejected from the tournament. No refund will be issued.
19. Each manager is responsible for the $\$ 250$ nonrefundable entry fee.
