Membership/Club Access Options*

Option 1

Individual Signature membership (Life Time 1): \$169 + tax per month

Signature memberships make a player's portion of court time fees free. (ex. 4 people play, 1 person is signature, and 3 are not, the signature member gets their portion for free, the other 3 pay their portion.) This is a great option if a player is looking to just use a lot of court time with friends, teammates, or for ball machine use.

There are additional in-club benefits included in this membership type.

Option 2

Individual 26 and under membership (ages 12-26): \$109 + tax per month (going up to \$119 Oct. 4, 2023)

This membership is for general club access, but a good option if you are looking at programming/lesson options over court time.

Option 3

Digital membership: \$15 + tax per month

This is a non-club access membership and gives access to Life Time online training programs.

Option 4

Non-Lakeville resident day rate: \$40 + tax

This gives a person a 1-day signature membership and would give the person their portion of court time for free.

Option 5

Lakeville Resident junior day rate: Ages 13-17= \$10.50 + tax, Age 12- \$6.50 (Valid for 6 months and requires parent waiver form filled out)

Must have a current Lakeville address or attend Lakeville schools. Does not include signature court time.

Court Time

Reserve a court for 1-4 players. Each player pays for their own court time. Signature members get their portion of court time for free. Ball machine rental is available for no additional cost.

Junior Tennis Program

These are regularly weekly scheduled programs that happen at the same day and time each week. They are scheduled in 8-12 week sessions depending on the time of year. Pro to student ratio is typically 1:6. It is also possible to put your own group of 6 together if there is a day, time, coach that would work better for your schedule. Session commitment would still be required. Classes are designed to cover both technical, tactical, and mental parts of tennis, and are great for playing against a wider range of player styles.

Private Lessons/Semi-Private Lessons

Private lessons are more personalized lessons where a lesson plan can be catered specifically to a player's needs. These can be scheduled as frequently as you would like and do not require a commitment (although if you would like to have a regular time with a specific pro, we recommend scheduling in advance as our courts are at max capacity during peak times during the cold months, as well as a pros schedule filling up). They can vary in time and length to cater to individual needs. The most common length for a private lesson is 1 hour but can go 30 minutes or 90 minutes. Semi-Private Lessons are the same, but can have 2,3, or 4 players in them. These are a great option to work on doubles tactics, or to take a lesson with a friend.

UTR (Universal Tennis Rating) Match Play

These are events that are scheduled across the Twin Cities at Life Time and non-Life Time facilities. Typically, these are events that include 1-2 matches at specific times, and matchups are determined by a player's UTR rating. UTR ratings are a key stat for college recruiting. USTA Tournaments

These are events scheduled across the Northern Section (Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, and western Wisconsin). Typically, these are weekend events, and schedules are determined after the registration window closes. Great for getting competition against players out of the immediate area.

Captains Practices

These are set up and paid for via the school booster club and are different than a court reservation. Schools typically fundraise to give players an opportunity to play indoors. Captain's practices usually happen at non-peak times like Saturday/Sunday afternoons, to allow members to play during peak times.
