- The roadmap issued states that organized youth activities can reopen in phase 2. Phase 2 is reached when there is no evidence of a rebound and that satisfy the gating criteria a second time.
- Phase 1 will still restrict to groups of 10 or less (which could eliminate the possibility of having a practice with an entire team).
- Develop a survey to send to members to get their thoughts.
