The Washington County News has been named the 2023 Kansas Basketball Coaches Association Media Outlet of the Year. The sports coverage for the WCN has been led by Backroads News & Media owner/publisher Dan Thalmann for the last several years. He took over for long-time sports editor Marcia Hubbard, who was also a KBCA award winner.

The sports coverage by the team of reporters and freelancers at the WCN has been honored with many awards from the Kansas Press Association during the last decade, including winning top awards in sports pages, sports photography and sports writing. The WCN was named the top mid-sized weekly newspaper in Kansas in 2015, 2016 and 2019.

Particular attention is given to stats, box scores, standings and records, to help serve as a historic archive of each schools' athletic programs.
