

Proof of Residency Documentation

Hockey Canada states that players must play in the Branch where their Parents reside. Residency is established by the usual residence of the Parents. "Usual Residence" is defined as living at the residence four (4) out of seven (7) days.

From the following list, proof of residency will be accepted with one (1) of the following:

- 1. Driver's License of one of the player's guardian
- 2. Water, Gas or Electricity Bill showing full address along with first and last name of one of the player's guardian.
- 3. Purchase agreement

If you do not have one of this, you will need to forward four (4) items of supporting documentation from the below eight (8) to verify residency. **NOTE**: Renting accommodations, paying utilities, and registering for school in a community can be done without establishing permanent residency.

- 1. School registration at a school near the residence for the current school year
- 2. Proof of mail delivery by Canada Post at the residence (box numbers are unacceptable)
- 3. Bills for utilities, cable, internet and/or landline telephone service at the residence
- 4. Lease agreement for a residence in parent(s) name(s)
- 5. Current property tax notice in parent(s) name(s)
- 6. Home/Renter's insurance policy for residence
- 7. Void cheque with residence address
- 8. Vehicle registration with residence address
- * All of the above must have Parent's name on the document
- **Any other documentation which supports your claim to residency at the address
