



Secaucus Men's Softball Bat Testing Policy

All bats will be tested prior to the season and before playoffs as well as any point during the game in which the pitcher is hit with a batted ball.

The league is not liable for any damage caused to the bat by the compression tester. It is at the owners risk to get the bat tested.

If a bat passes it will receive a passing sticker.

Coaches will have three bat challenges per night that can be used at any point

If a player fails the bat challenge during the game:

- The player using the bat is an automatic ejection for the remainder of the game.
 - The player can be subbed for defensively. If no substitutes available on bench that player can still play defense so the team is not at a disadvantage
 - That spot in the lineup is an automatic out
- The play that happened immediately prior to the challenge of that bat is an out.
- The bat now gets the league sticker removed
- The player who the bat is registered to and the player who used the bat are issued their warnings
 - 1st warning- Player using the bat is done for the night, owner gets verbal warning (if same person, the player is done for the night)
 - 2nd warning- Player using the bat and owner of the bat are issued two game suspensions
 - 3rd warning- Player using the bat and owner of the bat are suspended for the season.
- Player and owner of bat that fails compression test, for batted ball hitting the pitcher, will both be suspended for 3 additional games immediately.
