16. Opening Heights: Will be determined by the meet management

according to the WIAA format.

17. Field Events: The Long and Triple Jumps compete in order for

prelims and finals. Attempts must be taken in 1-1-1

format.

Discus is thrown on the track infield.

Long Jump Board: 9 feet from pit

Triple Jump Boards: 24, 28, 32, 36

Shot Put - Girls, followed by Boys Discus - Boys followed by Girls

Long Jump - Girls, followed by Boys (East Runway)
Triple Jump - Boys, followed by Girls (West Runway)
High Jump - 2 pits (Boys- Richey pits; Girls- UCS pits)

Pole Vault - Boys, followed by Girls

18. Video Viewing Areas

Video can only be reviewed with athletes in a designated coaches box.

-Long and Triple Jump coaches box is between the track and the bunting on the east side of the track. -Shot and Disc coaches box is outside of the track on the north end. -Vault is on the east side of the vault runway in the designated area. -High Jump is outside of the track on the south end.

-Running events can use any coaching box.

19. Equipment: Shots and Discus will be weighed and measured at

the storage garage in the Stadium.

20. Trainer: An athletic trainer from the Froedtert Sports Medicine

Group, Will George, will be on site all day.

21. Facility: Seal Flex, 8 lane track. Discus is thrown inside the

oval. Long and triple jump and pole vault runways are east of the track. High Jump located on the south end and the shot put is located on the north end of the track. 1/4" spikes OK, no "needle" spikes. Spectator seating only on the west side of the track or in designated bleacher

areas by field events.

22. Results: Results will be available to the coaches and press

immediately after the event on the WIAA website.

Results will be provided to the WIAA, The Wisconsin

State Journal and the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel. They will also be posted on our track & field website.
