In September of 2016, Northern Impact Volleyball Club was reorganized into a not for profit 501C3 and renamed Impact Volleyball Club, LLC. The Age Definition Policy was most recently revised by the USA Volleyball Board of Directors on January 19, 2002.

The classification cut-off date of September 1 was reviewed by the USAV Junior Assembly and the USA Regional Volleyball Association Assembly prior to and during the USAV 2014 Annual Meetings and research justified the continuation of the cut-off date of September 1.

 - For all girls 15-and-older (born Aug. 31, 2005 and before). ALL offers/holds expires Monday, Nov. 18th @ 7:00 pm.
 - When an offer is declined or an offer/hold expires, the coach will then call the next player in line for that position.
