#### The Board...

- Is responsible for **Business Operations** for the Association
- Is comprised of Association-elected members elected for a 3 year term
- Is responsible for:
  - Preparation of budgets, reconciliation of budgets to ice bills at end of season and monthly financials
  - Discipline or member grievances
  - Gambling efforts and funding
  - Public relations with the Association, rink personnel and community
  - Recruitment, retention
  - Fundraising
  - SafeSport compliance

  - Leadership of Volunteers, key committees, etc

#### The HDC. . .

- Is responsible for Hockey Operations for the Association
- Is a Board-approved committee responsible for:
  - Athlete skill development
  - Coaching selection and education recruitment and development of coaches throughout the season and ongoing year-to-year
  - Design and execution of the tryout process (Team Genius)
  - Developing and implementing programs for players and coaches at all levels to develop athletes and continually improve the quality of hockey in Shakopee

- Hockey compression shorts with velcro to hold up the hockey socks
- Shin guards
- Hockey socks and jerseys (will be provided)
- Skates
- Stick

#### Dibs – Volunteer Hours



- "Dibs" is the term that we use for **mandatory volunteer hours** that need to be completed by each family each year (examples include but not limited to: working the concession stand, helping with Try Hockey For Free, fundraiser pickup, etc.).
- At the start of the season, every family needs to write a forward-dated check to the Association, which we will cash if Dibs hours are not completed by the end of the season. Dibs check should be post-dated 5/1/2024.
- If Dibs are completed by the end of the season, and you are in good financial standing with the Association, your check will be destroyed.
- Dibs fill up fast so sign up quickly when new hours are posted (you will receive an email when they are posted).
- Dibs per family (18hrs), for new Mite families with their only player at this level (9hrs), for scholarship families (36hrs).

## Fundraiser – Heggie's



- Fundraising is vital to the success of our Association to reduce the cost of hockey
- Fundraising details:
  - What: Each player must sell at least \$120 worth of fundraising products. If 2 or more players in association, your fee is capped at \$240 per family.
  - When: Fundraising packets need to be turned in between November 25-27th at the Shakopee Hockey Ice Arena. Orders not submitted by end of day on 11/27 will not be counted. Order pickup is scheduled for Monday, December 11th in the lower parking lot of the Shakopee Community Center. Details on pick up times will be communicated at a later date.
  - Payment: We no longer accept check payments. All members will be billed through Sports Engine following packet turn-in. If payment is not received by pick-up date, the order will not be distributed.
  - Prizes/Swag: T-Shirts will be given to sellers who fundraise 20 items and T-Shirt & Sweatshirt to those who raise 60 items or more. Prize is for either shirt or sweatshirt, not for both. ValleySports will open a Pizza Fundraiser Shop on their website and families who are eligible will receive a discount code for their t-shirt or sweatshirt. You may also purchase gear from this shop, if desired.
