Janesville Parker is excited to once again host the Viking JV and Varsity Volleyball Tournament. The goal of this tournament is to provide a good deal of early season play in a competitive atmosphere. The format of the tournament is as follows for each level:

VARSITY & JV

- Play in the morning beginning at **8:30 am** - rally scoring 2 sets to 25 with a third set if necessary to 15
- Teams will be asked to help line judge and libero track when not competing. (varsity)
- After completion of 3 rounds of play there will be no more than a 30 minute lunch break.
- Tie Breakers
 - Head to head
 - Set percentage (between tied teams)
 - Points allowed (between tied teams)

JV Note: All teams will be competing at the same time. Each team is asked to provide a line judge and/or a libero tracker during their competition (parent if possible, extra manager, etc.)

Miscellaneous:

- **Please bring your own warm-up balls.**
- The gyms will be open 1 hour before play begins.
- Your teams are responsible for line judges, scoreboard operator as well as libero trackers during a bye round.
- Warm ups will be 3/3/1 for each team's first round of play; after those round, 3/3/1.
- The admission for spectators is \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students. Each school is allowed a traveling party of 20 people (consisting of athletes, coaches, and managers) that will be given free admission. This DOES NOT include parents, chaperones or siblings. Thanks for your cooperation.
- Please **NO CARRY-INS** into the school. Concessions will be sold as a fundraiser for the host teams. Please keep team coolers outside. Thank you.
- Tournament Directors will be monitoring courts on a continuous basis throughout the tournament.
