### Learn to Skate Member

Skaters who participate in group Learn to Skate Classes for Basic 1-6 and Pre-Free Skate thru Free Skate 6 are considered *Basic Skills Members* of MSLFSC. The following rules apply to Basic Skills Members:

- Unable to test with the USFSA, compete or purchase contract ice time
- Volunteer requirement must be met
- Eligible to participate in Ice Show
- Receives USFSA Learn to Skate *Skating Magazine* Subscription
- Annual fee: \$16

### Full Club Member

Members who purchase contract ice for individual practice time must be Full Club Members. The following rules apply to Full Club Members:

- Full Club Members are eligible to test with the USFSA, compete at all USFSA sanctioned competitions and purchase MSLFSC practice ice
- Volunteer requirement must be met
- Eligible to participate in Ice Show
- Eligible for a Feature number in Ice Show
- Receives USFSA *Skating Magazine* subscription
- Annual fee: \$60

### Associate Member

Skaters who are Full Club members of another USFSA club may be Associate Club Members of MSLFSC. The following rules apply to Associate Club Members:

- Skater is able to purchase practice ice time through MSLFSC
- No volunteer requirement
- Eligible to participate in Ice Show
- Eligible for Feature number in Ice Show if full club members interested is low.
- Not eligible for an Ice Show solo
- Annual fee: \$50

### Junior Club - Sundays

For skaters in Basic Skills 1-6, Junior Club provides an opportunity to practice skills that are learned during the basic skills classes.

Junior Club is available for skaters who are not taking individual private lessons from a coach.

Club Helpers and a certified instructor will circulate around the ice to provide tips and suggestions for skaters who wish to work on particular skills

**Production Ensemble Teams:** Production team is limited to 28 skaters. 20 on PET and 8 on Mini-Production to be assigned. You are required to be in all ice show performances. Practice will be held on Sundays (time TBD) and/or Wednesdays at 8:30. Both teams will compete at the Badger State Games. Teams will be assigned by co-head coaches and approved by a committee of 2-3 board members. Assignments will be emailed prior to the Skater/Parent Meeting in September. You must accept or decline your assignment within 48 hours of receiving the email. Failure to fulfill a team commitment because it is not your first choice may affect future assignments for teams and/or ice show features.

**Synchronized Skating:** Synchro will offer 2 teams. Skills team or competition teams are limited to 32 skaters total and skaters will be assigned to the appropriate team based on skill, prior experience, and USFSA competition requirements. Co-head coaches assign teams with the goal of allowing the team to be competitive and successful. Synchro members will be expected to perform in all ice show performances.

Fee includes:

- Competition team: Badger State Games registration fee
- Skills Team: Ice Show registration fee
- Costumes, tights, and additional competitions will be extra

**\*\*Skaters may select BOTH PET and Synchro for teams. However, if the team(s) are full, the skater will be assigned to one team based on the needs of the team for the current skating season.\*\***

Assignments will be emailed prior to the Skater/Parent Meeting in September. You must accept or decline your assignment within 48 hours of receiving the email. Failure to fulfill a team commitment because it is not your first choice may affect future assignments for teams and/or ice show features.

**High School team: High School aged skaters that have passed FS 2 and above. \*\*Separate information emailed to all eligible skaters in April. See Expectations and Guidelines\*\***

### Optional Ice Show Feature Performance:

#### GUIDELINES

#### To participate in the Marshfield Silver Laces Ice Show:

1. You must be a current member of Marshfield Silver Laces to be eligible to participate in the ice show.
2. You must be in good standing with Marshfield Silver Laces, which is defined as : all prior ice contracts, ice show fees, LTS fees, and Coaching fees must be paid in full and have no athletic code of conduct violations.
3. Associate members are eligible to perform in group numbers. If the number of Full Club members interested in a feature is less than 20, Associate members may apply for a feature. If Full Club members exceed 20, they will not be eligible for a feature.
4. Feature level skaters must skate one or more times per week at the Marshfield rink and receive at least ten private lessons during contract ice with a Marshfield Silver Laces coach during the 2019-20 skating season.
5. You must be able to attend all practices and ice show performances – only one practice may be missed and it will need to be reported to the show director and designated coach (es) **prior** to the absence.
6. Skaters will participate in all numbers designated by the show director/committee.
7. To qualify for a specialty number or solo you must meet the following requirements:

#### Feature Determination Criterion:

1. Must be a Full Club Member for a minimum of 2 years for a Solo
2. Skater must **pass** Free Skate 1 or above as of first Sunday in October
3. Features will be assigned in order of points earned through USFS testing (Freestyle, Dance and MIF), skater preference, and ice show committee's determination of appropriateness for skill, age, height, and the need to have a balanced ice show.
4. Ice Show Committee will make final decisions for Solos/Spotlight solos. Every attempt will be made to vary feature assignments each year.
5. In the event of a tie for solos, a "tiebreaker" will be based on:  
-Points earned, age, years in club, and/or solos may be divided so each skater performs in two ice shows
6. Skater must work with a private lesson coach during contract ice throughout the skating season, October thru February

All feature assignments will be determined by the Ice Show Committee and Head Coaches. Deadline to register for an ice show feature is **First Sunday of October (October 6, 2019)**.
