



# 2019 LUVERNE BASKETBALL CLASSIC

## Rules

- Halves will be sixteen minutes of running time. The clock will stop the last (1) minute of each half.
- The clock will stop at all time-outs and at the referee's discretion.
- Overtime periods will be two minutes with a maximum of two two-minute overtimes, then sudden death.
- Teams will be given (1) 45-second time out each half (timeouts do not carry over to overtime) and one per overtime period.
- Boys teams in both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade will use a men's basketball.
- All technical fouls will result in the automatic awarding of two points to the opposing team, plus the ball out-of-bounds.
- Coaches must remain in the bench area during games.
- Coaches are to fill out score sheets during warm-up.
- National High School Federation Basketball & MSHSL rules shall be used unless otherwise noted.
- Pressing will be allowed unless pressing team has more than a 15-point lead.
- Each team shall provide their own warm up balls. Game ball will be provided.
- Players may play up a grade. Players may play for one team only.
- Teams should be ready to play at least 30 minutes ahead of schedule.
- No protests will be honored, all referees decisions are final!
- NO TOLERANCE for unsportsmanlike conduct- any parent, fan, coach or player displaying disrespect to officials or players will be asked to leave with no refunds granted.
- 10 team medals will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams in each division
- Pool Play winners will be determined by the following criteria:
  1. Overall Record
  2. Head to head competition
  3. Point Differential
  4. Coin Toss
- If the weather does not allow us to have the tournament, teams will be refunded \$100 of their \$125 entry fee.
