NCAA, NAIA, NJCAA: What's the Difference?

If you are looking to get a athetic scholarship in the U.S, you've got a lot of options. The main organizations which give out sports scholarships are the NCAA, NAIA, and the NJCAA. Here we will go over the differences between these organizations, and how to know which sports scholarship available.







NCAA

The National College Athletics Association (NCAA) is the most well-known and esteemed college sports organization in the USA. There are three divisions of the NCAA.

Divisions 1 and 2 are the only ones which offer sports scholarships! Whereas the NCAA D1 and D2 schools are large universities, the D3 is usually small colleges. While you won't be able to get an athletic scholarship at the D3 level, you might be able to get an academic scholarship.








NAIA

The National Association of Intercollegiate Athletes is mostly comprised of smaller private universities. The athletic and academic requirements aren't as high as with the NCAA.







NJCAA

The National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) is the organization that oversees college sports from Junior Colleges, Community Colleges and State Colleges.

The sports association consists of 24 regions and is divided into three divisions. The academic level and tuition costs are lower than at other universities, and different eligibility rules apply compare to the NAIA and NCAA.




