

PGYA PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Pleasant Grove Youth Association Board members have implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our league.

Coaches, parents, spectators, or players who display actions, or attitudes which disrupts the smooth and orderly running of the game will be removed from the sports facility and be suspended from the following game. Repeat violations may cause a multiple game suspension, or the season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games. A PGYA Board member or game official reserves the right to remove fans or coaches.

- ✓ I will support my child by giving encouragement and avoiding negative criticism.
- ✓ I will do my best to ensure my child attends all practices and games.
- ✓ I will respect my child's teammates, coaches, game officials, and fellow parents.
- ✓ I will support my child's coach and will avoid coaching from the sidelines.
- ✓ I will communicate with my child's coach directly and not through my child.
- ✓ I will NEVER use profanity, abusive language, or threatening behavior towards the players, other parents, coaches, or officials.
- ✓ I will never engage in an argument with a referee or official and all opposing coaches and players will be treated with respect.
- ✓ I will lead by example and always demonstrate good sportsmanship during the games.
- ✓ I will respect the equipment and facilities made available to my child for practices and games.
